Veterans Day is a significant November observance that deserves recognition alongside Thanksgiving. This day, observed annually on November 11, honors those who have served in the military, acknowledging their vital role in protecting our freedoms. While showing gratitude to veterans should be ongoing, Veterans Day is a dedicated occasion for people worldwide to come together to celebrate their contributions. Below are essential facts about Veterans Day, including current veteran statistics.

Veterans Day is distinct from Memorial Day. Many people confuse these two holidays, but they serve different purposes. Veterans Day honors all who have served in any branch of the military, whether in times of war or peace, highlighting thanks to living veterans. In contrast, Memorial Day specifically commemorates military personnel who died in service to the country.

The choice of November 11 as Veterans Day has historical roots. It marks the anniversary of the 1918 armistice that ended World War I—the “eleventh hour of the eleventh day of the eleventh month.” Initially called Armistice Day, the holiday was renamed Veterans Day in 1954 by President Dwight D. Eisenhower to recognize veterans of all wars.

Other nations also observe similar commemorations around November 11. Countries such as Great Britain, France, Australia, and Canada honor their veterans on or near this date, often calling it Remembrance Day. This reflects the shared sacrifices of military members among allied nations during the World Wars.

The first Veterans Day parade took place in Birmingham, Alabama,

in 1947. This location was chosen because Raymond Weeks, a World War II veteran from Birmingham, successfully advocated for the establishment of a national holiday to honor all veterans. The parade remains an annual tradition there, accompanied by various events including a veterans award reception and memorial services.

A pressing issue linked to veterans is mental health, specifically suicide among military personnel. The Military Suicide Awareness #22ADAY movement draws attention to the alarming statistic that approximately 22 veterans die by suicide each day in the United States—equivalent to one every 65 minutes. This movement connects volunteers and advocates working to address this tragic reality and provide support for veterans suffering from post-traumatic stress.

Despite declines in numbers, millions of veterans still warrant recognition. As of October 2019, the U.S. counted around 18.2 million veterans, 9% of whom are women. Expressing gratitude with phrases like “Thank you for your service” remains the most meaningful way to honor veterans on this day. Beyond words, attending Veterans

Day events or supporting veterans through kind actions are impactful ways to show appreciation. If you are in the Quartzsite area join the VFW on the back patio at 11:11am for a Veterans Day Ceremony. Otherwise, check with your local VFW, American Legion or other Veteran organization for events in your area.

Veterans Day not only commemorates the sacrifices of military service members but also calls for ongoing respect and support for veterans. These acknowledgments reflect on the freedoms safeguarded through their dedication and sacrifice, reminding us to continually honor their service. 



### Health Practitioners are Combining Forces to Find the Truth

### Who Are The Real Kings?

So-called King, Donald Trump, ran in two contested Republican primaries. He ran three times in a general election. He was elected twice, and his party recently won a Republican Congress. In contrast, in 2020, Joe Biden did not run a typical campaign. He avoided the public, staying ensconced in his basement. He outsourced his campaign to Democratic politicians, donors, and a sycophantic media.

No red state ever sought to remove Joe Biden or Kamala Harris from their 2024 ballots.

In contrast, twenty-five blue states attempted to take Trump off their ballots. In 2021, Joe Biden's DOJ and FBI raided then-former-President Trump's home. They found only 102 classified documents among some 14,000 seized, but nevertheless indicted him.

There was no such SWAT raid on Biden's multiple repositories of illegally removed classified documents. All were in less secure places than at Mar-a-Lago. Biden removed them over the course of three decades with impunity. At the time (unlike Trump) he had no presidential prerogatives to declassify them. Special counsel Robert Hur found Biden culpable for the removal of these files but declined to prosecute, claiming that he was too enfeebled to stand trial.

In 2024, the same backroom donors and politicians who had conspired to ensure Biden was the 2020 nominee now, against his wishes, in coup-like fashion, removed him from his own reelection ticket. Within 48 hours and without a delegate vote, they crowned Kamala Harris as the presumed nominee. Queen Harris had not received a single delegate vote in her disastrous 2020 primary run.

Donald Trump, in 2020, did not sic his Department of Justice on his rival, Joe Biden. Nor during his presidency did his Department of Justice indict any past or future political opponent or ex-president. In contrast, Kingly Joe Biden's White House helped coordinate 91 indictments of his past and future presidential rival, ex-president Donald Trump.

A mere three days after Trump announced his reelection bid on November 15, 2022, Jack Smith was coincidentally appointed special prosecutor of Trump. That same day, strangely, Nathan Wade, the Georgia county prosecutor prosecuting Trump, met with Biden's

White House counsel. On the same day, Matthew Colangelo, the former lead prosecutor in Letitia James's case against Trump, abruptly left his DOJ post. He would soon go on to lead Manhattan prosecutor Alvin Bragg's prosecution of Trump.

In the 2020 election, Joe Biden's surrogates rounded up 51 "intelligence authorities" to lie that Hunter Biden's authentic and incriminating laptop (then verified but suppressed by the FBI) was the work of the Russians. The Biden-era FBI also joined Twitter, Facebook, and other social media to help smother any media story that might have verified the authenticity of the laptop.

The left portrays Trump's constitutional right to pardon as the act of a king. In his nearly five years of governance, Trump has pardoned roughly 1,700, including about 1,500 en masse for those convicted for the January 6 FEDsurrection. That number so far is about 200 fewer pardons than during the Obama administration.

Joe Biden, in a mere four years in office, pardoned roughly 4,245 people—the vast majority through au-

topen signatures and without the full knowledge of Biden himself. Under the Obama and Biden administrations, admitted left-wing government lawbreakers and White House allies were never prosecuted for felonious behavior.

CIA head John Brennan admitted to lying twice to Congress. Director of National Intelligence James Clapper confessed to lying under oath to Congress as well. FBI Director James Comey claimed ignorance or amnesia 245 times while under oath to a House oversight committee. Interim FBI Director Andrew McCabe lied four times, often while under oath to government investigators.

A federal judge in 2020 admonished John Bolton, Trump's former National Security Advisor and vehement critic, that he had endangered national security by removing sensitive documents to write an anti-Trump campaign-cycle memoir. He also warned Bolton that he could be subject to civil and criminal penalties. Not one of these political grandees was ever indicted by either the Obama or Biden DOJ.

Trump's White House advisors Steve Bannon and Peter Navarro were arrested in public for ignoring a congressional subpoena, convicted, and imprisoned. In contrast, top Democrat officials like former attorneys general Eric Holder and Merrick Garland both ignored congressional subpoenas and faced no such indictments.

Monarchs might order assassinations of U.S. citizens abroad and surveil the phone records of Associated Press reporters. Obama did both during his tenure. ### Getting Out of the UN: An Idea That's Catching On!

The United Nations came into existence on October 24, 1945 — 80 years ago this year. During the world body's early years, politicians and pundits praised it almost universally, such as when President John F. Kennedy described it in his January 20, 1961 inauguration speech as "our

last best hope in an age where the instruments of war have far outpaced the instruments of peace." He continued, "We renew our pledge of support [to the UN] — to prevent it from becoming merely a forum for invective — to strengthen its shield of the new and the weak — and to enlarge the area in which its writ may run."

JFK's pledge to strengthen the UN was not mere rhetoric. In September 1961, the U.S. State Department released, and JFK submitted to the UN General Assembly, a "disarmament" plan titled Freedom From War: The United States Program for General and Complete Disarmament in a Peaceful World. Under this plan, in the third of three stages, "progressive controlled disarmament and continuously developing principles and procedures of international law would proceed to a point where no state would have the military power to challenge the progressively strengthened U.N. Peace Force."

That plan was in accord with the vision of the UN's founders, who claimed that an empowered UN would enforce world peace. Ignored in this utopian dream was that such a monopoly of power could also be used to impose global tyranny.

The threat of UN global governance is much more widely understood today than it was at the time of the UN's founding or during the Kennedy years. But even then, Americans who did recognize the danger of strengthening the UN were sounding the alarm and warning fellow citizens. In January 1962, The John Birch Society formally launched its "long-range project" to get the United States out of the UN. Over the ensuing decades, Birchers have had a profound effect in bringing about today's widespread anti-UN sentiment. In fact,

that sentiment has reached a point where the



Birch slogan to "Get US Out!" sounds no longer bizarre but sensible — even mainstream. The days when the UN was predominantly viewed as mankind's last, best hope for peace have long since passed.

So President Donald Trump's anti-UN remarks

in his address to the UN General Assembly on September 23 of this year resonated with everyday Americans. For instance, he said the UN is "actually creating new problems for us to solve." He cited as the "best example" of this "the No.1 political issue of our time, the crisis of uncontrolled migration." He said that the UN is "funding an assault on Western countries and their borders"- including the United States. "Think of that: The UN is supporting people that are illegally coming into the United States, and then we have to get them out."

Trump also decried what's being done "in the name of pretending to stop the global warming hoax," adding, "The entire globalist concept of asking successful, industrialized nations to inflict pain on themselves and radically disrupt their entire societies must be rejected immediately.... That's why in America, I withdrew from the fake [UN] Paris Climate Accord."

However, in his remarks Trump fell short — far short — of calling for U.S. withdrawal from the UN itself. Instead, he lamented that the UN has "tremendous potential, but it's not even coming close to living up to that potential." After his speech, he told UN Secretary-General António Guterres, "Our country is behind the United Nations 100 percent.... I may disagree with it sometimes, but I am so behind it because I think the potential for peace at this institution is so great."

Enabling the UN to achieve its potential (as JFK wanted to do back in 1961) is exactly what not to do. Rather than reform or empower the UN, we must get out, as The John Birch Society has long advocated. ### Rand Paul Supports Massie Against Trump's Attacks

Two of America's most constitutionally obedient legislators are banding together to weather President Donald Trump's attacks. Interestingly, the positions that have made them lightning rods for Trump's ire are similar to the ones George Washington promoted in his Farewell Address.

Senator Rand Paul (R-Ky.) recently told POLITICO's Dasha Burns that he was going to help fellow Kentuckian and libertarian kindred spirit Representative Thomas Massie (R) win his primary race in 2026. Massie has always had a stubborn independent streak, but he's made 2025 a record year of dissent. He opposed the president's choice for speaker of the house, the One Big Beautiful Bill, and the decision to bomb Iran. He's also led an effort to have all Justice Department files on Jeffrey Epstein released, despite various actions congressional Republicans have taken in the name of similar transparency.

By summer, Trump had enough. He deployed his political machine on a

mission to unseat and replace Massie. Two weeks ago, Trump endorsed a combat veteran named Ed Gallrein, who, based on public comments he's made in the past, appears more aligned with Trump's interventionist foreign policy than Massie ever was. Gallrein failed to win his race for a seat in the Kentucky State Senate last year, but now he's got the backing of Trump's political juggernaut.

"With Him Every Step of the Way" Paul, who holds nearly identical positions to Massie's, seemed confident that his friend was going to prevail. He told POLITICO, "Thomas Massie is going to win, I'm going to help him, I'm going to be with him every step of the way. I campaigned with him a month ago. We had big rallies and a great deal of support. So, people who think they can waltz into Kentucky with a bunch of New York money and buy a seat, they've got another thing coming."

Paul is referring to the collection of



neocon billionaires who are spending big money to oust Massie. As we've previously reported, the people behind the MAGA KY PAC are John Paulson,

Paul Singer, and the Preserve America PAC, whose primary financier is Miriam Adelson, according to the Federal Election Commission (FEC). They have been central funding figures of the Establishment apparatus for years.

Paul pointed out to POLITICO that Massie's fight to keep his seat has implications beyond this one race. He said: "I think what Thomas Massie represents is something bigger than him, bigger than me, and bigger than just one Congressional seat. What he represents is an independent voice within the Republican Party, a voice that believes in the Constitution and a strict interpretation of the enumerated powers, who believes in balanced budgets, low taxes and less foreign war."

#### Traitor to MAGA?

Paul is the Senate's version of Massie. He, too, voted against Trump's Big Beautiful Bill and is profoundly bothered by the government's reckless deficit spending. And he, too, opposes the president's inclinations to take military action without congressional approval. Recently, Paul has been railing against the administration's latest habit of blowing up boats in the ocean. The Trump administration says the boats were occupied by Venezuelan drug runners delivering deadly poison to America.

That might be true, Paul has said, but it's unethical and in violation of maritime law to "blow them to smithereens" without any attempt to confirm who and what is onboard. "Is it too much to ask to know the names of those we killed before we killed them? To know what evidence exists of their guilt?" he recently said during a speech on the Senate floor. Yes, apparently it is.

Paul's recent announcement that he was going to stump for Massie has earned him the label of traitor, oddly, by figures in the same political camp. Dinesh D'Souza, a center-right commentator who holds many otherwise

sensible positions, called Paul's support for Massie a betrayal. On Sunday, he said Paul should be primaried as well for backing Massie.

#### Divided MAGA

Perhaps some of these replies came from bots or propaganda accounts. But even if they did, they illustrate a legitimate divide in the MAGA camp. Supporters of Massie and Paul argue they're the real America First politicians and accuse Trump of having abandoned the movement, especially when it comes to foreign intervention. Paul mentioned Trump's departure on MAGA foreign policy during his interview with POLITICO. "Regime change is not a part of Donald Trump's psyche," he said. "He's been opposed to it. So if they get involved in regime change in Venezuela, that is something that is inconsistent with his instincts."

Others tend to view the kerfuffle between Trump and Massie through a tribalistic lens. Because Trump hates the Democrats, and because of the good that he's done (he has implemented solid immigration, energy, and culture policies) anyone who opposes him is an enemy. Their loyalty appears to be more to Trump and the GOP than what is legitimately good for the country.

In his interview with POLITICO, Paul highlighted the two major points of contention between Massie and Trump: those concerning government spending and foreign intervention. Despite Trump's good policies, he's on track to continue more than half a century of empire building and deficit spending.

Massie and Paul are among the very few, in many instances the only ones, in Trump's party who are not afraid to publicly point out Trump's errors. Both have said there are other Republicans who share their concerns. They've spoken to these people privately, but such people are too scared to say anything on the record. They're afraid they, too, would incur Trump's wrath. And they're afraid to lose their next race and have to go back home.

### Washington's Warnings

George Washington wanted to go home long before he finally got to. Before departing for Mount Vernon, he wrote a farewell address, which was published in multiple newspapers. The address was supposed to serve as advice for future generations of Americans, a "disinterested warning," as he called it, on how to create a flourishing republic.

Washington told early Americans to "sacredly maintain" the U.S. Constitution. He said that allegiance to parties — the "baneful effects of the Spirit of Party" — would "become potent engines by which cunning, ambitious, and unprincipled men will be enabled to subvert the Power of the People and to usurp for themselves the reins of Government." Allegiance to parties will lead to despotism, he clarified. It will "incline the minds of men to seek security and repose in the absolute power of an Individual," who will "sooner or later" turn "this disposition to the purposes of his own elevation, on the ruins of Public Liberty."

Washington also said that each branch of government should stay in its constitutional lane, because the "spirit of encroachment tends to consolidate the powers of all departments in one, and thus to create, whatever the form of government, a real despotism." Anyone who has read the entire address has likely noticed that Washington was very preoccupied with concern that the American government could turn despotic.

More to Paul's and Massie's point, Washington advised against "the accumulation of debt, not only by shunning occasions of expense," but by using times of peace to pay off war debt. He pointed out that debt requires revenue to pay off, and revenue comes by way of taxes, and the problem with taxes is that they can be "inconvenient" and "unpleasant." Sadly, we rarely hear today's politicians express concern for the burdens their reckless fiscal sorcery imposes on regular Americans.



prescribed a be-a-good-neighbor foreign policy. "Observe good faith and justice towards all Nations" and "cultivate peace and harmony with all," he said. It's the moral thing to do. A just, benevolent nation is a benefit to the entire world, he wisely pointed out.

He promoted a foreign policy that doesn't favor one nation over another. Instead of "inveterate antipathies against particular nations and passionate attachments for others," he suggested "amicable feelings towards all." He advised against getting tied up in entangling alliances. A nation that harbors ill will toward another is inclined to get drawn into war. He said: "Sympathy for the favourite nation, facilitating the illusion of an imaginary common interest in cases where no real common interest exists, and infusing onto one the enmities of the other, betrays the former into participating in the quarrels and wars of the latter, without adequate inducement of justification."

He later espouses a doctrine of non-intervention. "Tis our true policy to steer clear of permanent alliances, with any portion of the foreign world," he wrote. And when we do form any alliances, they should only be temporary and "for extraordinary emergencies." As for when military action should be taken, that's simple, he said. It should be based "on a respectable defensive posture."

Washington also warned against foreign influence at home, something Massie has as well. Washington: "Against the insidious wiles of foreign influence, I conjure you to believe me, fellow citizens, the jealousy of a free people ought to be constantly awake, since history and experience is one of the most baneful foes of Republican Government."

He added that we should do business with other nations, but have "as little political connection as possible." America is in a unique geographical position, he said — a "detached and distant situation" — that enables her to stay out of problems caused by "belligerent nations." So why leave "to stand upon foreign ground?"

If Washington were to drop in today, who would he support? Massie or Trump? Which of these two men's vision of how the government should

operate is more aligned with Washington's vision of America First? The answer is blatantly clear.

### More Massies Needed

America needs more Massies, more Pauls — more constitutionalists. Massie's score in TNA's Freedom Index is one point shy of perfect, 99 percent. Paul is not far behind at 94 percent. Both have been in Congress for almost the same amount of time, since the early 2010s. They are part of a growing cohort of lawmakers who have shown a knowledge of and respect for the U.S. Constitution.

Eli Crane (R-Ariz.) has voted along Constitutional lines 98 percent of the time during his two sessions in the House. Representative Andy Biggs, another Arizona Republican, has managed a very respectable 95 percent. Utah's Republican senator, Mike Lee, is another Congressional veteran, like Paul and Massie. His voting record aligns with the Constitution 94 percent of the time.

There are other promising newcomers. Sheri Biggs (R-S.C.) has been perfect in her freshman year. Oklahoman Josh Brecheen (R) has illustrated during his short stint in Congress that he's willing to stay true to the Constitution.

His score is a spotless 100. There's also the fiery Georgian, Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene, and Colorado Representative Lauren Boebert, both of whom have accumulated scores in the 90s.

### America First

The reason we (JBS.org) publish the Freedom Index is because we believe the key to American restoration is a return to constitutional principles, values that made this country so great to live in. People from all over the world have risked their lives to come here for 250 years. That's not an accident. Unfortunately, the values and principles that made this country so great have been under assault for a century.

The fight between Massie and Trump will determine if a truly America First, constitutionally aligned movement is on the march. Massie is receiving donations from people all over the country. Have Americans awakened? Are there enough who realize that political rivalry was always a sneaky way for the Establishment to fool us into cheering on our own demise? For the sake of all Americans, we dearly hope so. The Kentuckians of House District 4 are going to tell us if MAGA is truly dedicated to America First principles.

### Are Democrats Trying To Start a Civil War?

Whenever you consider the course of internal conflict within a nation, you often hear post-crisis voices claiming, “We never saw it coming,” or lamenting, “Violence hit us out of nowhere.” In truth, these are the people who simply weren’t paying enough attention. Today, I see a significant part of American society (perhaps a quarter) radicalized beyond reason or repair. This mass of leftists, cocooned in propaganda, functions as a hive mind obeying gatekeepers without question. Reason is futile; they hunger for power and the suffering of anyone who opposes their worldview.

Contrast this with conservatives, who value independence so much it leads to endless in-fighting. We might align on core values, but even there, we manage to quarrel. The left, by contrast, immediately ostracizes any dissenter; their collective cannot tolerate rebellion unless dictated by the gatekeepers. Oddly, this lines up conservatives with a desire for order. While leftists, in their uniformity, seek chaos and the breakdown of civilization. You’d expect a reversal, but history proves otherwise.

If you look at the aftermath of the Bolshevik Revolution or various Marxist disruptions post-WWI, Europeans shouldn’t have been surprised when conflict erupted. Most people naturally rallied behind heritage—against moral relativism peddled by radical leftists. The popularity of fascism, for all its horrors, arose from the shelter it offered against communist mayhem. Brutality often followed, but it was a response to existential threat rather than a vacuum, driven by a desire to prevent communist havoc.

Both fascism and communism are authoritarian, with tragic conse-

quences. Communist tactics (economic sabotage, mobs, and violent politics) almost always precede a fascist crackdown. Societies do not embrace the iron fist willingly; it’s thrust upon them by chaos.

So, can subversion be defeated without resorting to authoritarianism? Is a constitutional republic strong enough to withstand internal warfare waged against its foundations? When your society faces such a war, can you fight back civilly and still win? Probably not. What we see now in the US and Europe is a Marxist/Communist insurgency. We have moved past propaganda and mob influence into open political violence—assassination attempts and civilian terror attacks becoming more common.

The architects of today’s woke communist

movement are clearly Democrat politicians and media influencers. They fan flames of hysteria and violence, spin stories to defend groups like Antifa, and justify violence as necessary resistance. Ask Democrats why they continue their militant course and you’ll hear, “Trump is a dictator and a fascist.” Yet, no one can present a genuine example of Trump acting dictatorially.

Deportations? Nearly every country enforces strict immigration laws—often harsher than Trump’s administration. Cuts to federal programs? Those are within presidential powers. The National Guard in cities? Democrat local leaders collaborate with activists to disrupt ICE and endanger agents. If they oppose federal enforcement, they shouldn’t wage war on immigration officials. Every Trump action gets inflated into an “end of democracy” scenario, which only drives his opponents to greater extremes.

The ongoing government shutdown

is a focal point for this agenda. Democrats could quickly reopen the government but refuse, blaming Republicans and seeking to maximize public suffering for leverage. Trump is scapegoated for EBT and SNAP disruptions, while Democrats manipulate their “free-stuff army”—entitled, easy to stir.

Democrats crave a drawn-out shutdown, feeding fear and instability. If Republicans give in, Democrats will repeat the threat, retaking control even when out of power. The rhetoric is escalating. DNC Chair Ken Martin recently forecasted the end of elections, hinting at future authoritarian rule and “resistance” becoming truly militant. Senator Chuck Schumer calls for forceful uprising

against Trump, labeling it tyranny and dictatorship.

MSNBC’s Joy Reid and Jasmine Crockett amplify the call: “Pick up a weapon—vote, protest sign, whatever it takes. This isn’t politics anymore, it’s survival.” Crockett agrees: “This is a war... The other side declared war on us long ago.” This rhetoric is echoed by Democrats online, who openly express desires for conservative deaths and retribution against Trump supporters. Yet, if we’re under fascist rule as they claim, how can leftists hope for a return to power? If elections remain, their arguments about tyranny ring hollow.

Look at the New York mayor’s race, which unfolded as predicted. Champagne socialist Zohran Mamdani leads the polls, a fusion of all anti-West groups into a single candidate. Democrats double down on this approach—failures are ignored, and radicalism is the only way forward, according to figures like AOC and Bernie Sanders. With violent conflict looming, Democrats promise revenge on conservatives if they regain power, making peace impossible.

If Democrat leaders keep disrupting deportations and menacing federal agents, sooner or later, public support will shift toward National

Guard intervention—maybe even the arrest of complicit politicians. Should leftists incite violence over lost benefits, the gatekeepers themselves may be removed. The constitutionality of such responses is debatable, but the left’s provocations are undeniable—they’re making peaceful resolution unattainable.

They’ve gone so far off the rails that one must ask: Is this an active attempt to trigger civil war or an authoritarian backlash? Do they think instability will bring them victory?

I’ve long posited Trump’s role as the ideal scapegoat for a leftist/globalist manufactured collapse. If conservatives and patriots ever achieved real governmental power, elites would deliberately crash the system and blame them for the fallout. This appears to be happening now. Progressive gatekeepers weaponize far-left activists as cannon fodder to provoke crises, just as Lenin and Trotsky—both from relative wealth—manipulated the poor. Marx himself lived off rich benefactors. The gatekeepers don’t share the plight of the working class; they exploit it for power. The mentally unstable and naïve masses constitute useful fools in a grander agenda.

Democrat leaders direct this chaos at the heart of America, hoping conservatives get blamed for their inevitable and uncompromising response. Perhaps they hope conservatives will embrace authoritarianism in desperate self-defense, becoming the true villains. They underestimate the American resolve for restoring order; playing the victim will not save them.

It’s hard to foresee an outcome without major conflict and bloodshed. Honestly, the left may bear the brunt of this. For self-preservation, I hope they soon realize they are mere pawns in a much larger scheme—abandoned by their own gatekeepers once their utility runs out.

### Technocrats & Transhumanists

Technocracy has always had the domination of man and his actions in mind, even from its inception. As technology has advanced, it has been commandeered at every turn to support technocracy's stated purposes of "the science of engineering," abolition of private property, scientific dictatorship, and sequestration of all resources, among others. Transhumanism, on the other hand, seeks to dominate our bodies and all that pertains to being human. Both are patently anti-human, and they are doubly dangerous when brought together.

When "technocracy" was first codified in 1932 at Columbia University, there was a lot of talk about biological processes alongside industrial processes. For instance, the Technocracy Study Course in 1934 stated: "Technocracy is dealing with social phenomena in the widest sense of the word; this includes not only actions of human beings, but also everything which directly or indirectly affects their actions. Consequently, the studies of technocracy embrace practically the whole field of science and industry. Biology, climate, natural resources, and industrial equipment all enter into the social picture." This might be the earliest mention of biology and natural resources together, and it clearly equates biological processes and natural resources.

Fast-forward to the 1992 Earth Summit (the UN Conference on Environment and Development, or UNCED) in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil,

where Agenda 21 was hatched and the United Nations held a parallel Convention on Biological Diversity. (This was a common practice with large conferences.) The 1995, 1,200-page, thoroughly technocratic Global Biodiversity Assessment described how Agenda 21 and Sustainable Development would be implemented.

In 1994, two participants at the original UNCED conference wrote the book *The Earth Brokers* to explain how the definition of biodiversity was quietly changed. They wrote: "The convention implicitly equates the diversity of life — animals and plants — to the diversity of genetic codes, for which read genetic resources. By doing so, diversity becomes something that modern science can manipulate.... The convention promotes biotechnology as being "essential for the conservation and sustainable use of biodiversity."

The main stake raised by the Biodiversity Convention is the issue of ownership and control over biological diversity.... The major concern was protecting the pharmaceutical and emerging biotechnology industries." To reinforce the thought, the authors bluntly stated, "They wrote up a convention on how to 'develop' the use of biodiversity through patents and biotechnology." The bottom line is that for the first time, humans were mixed in with all the other living things on Earth to be bioengineered, patented, and owned.

Fast-forward to Covid-19. Big Pharma saw no problem in injecting 72 percent of the world's population with an unapproved, experimental mRNA shot that killed hundreds of thousands, if not millions, and injured many more. There was no pretense of consent: Take the shot, or else! The leadership of Big Pharma saw the world's people like so many cattle in a feed lot, and it showed.

#### *The Advent of NBIC, Convergent Science*

Technocracy and transhumanism were just kissing cousins for most of the 20th century, but now they are like Siamese twins joined at the hip. "Convergent science," or NBIC, changed everything. NBIC stands for Nano (nanotechnology), Bio (biotechnology), Info (information technology) and Cogno (cognitive sciences). These four scientific disciplines remained separate avenues of study in universities around the world until the early 1970s, but today NBIC is an established discipline of its own in most major universities, with personnel contributed from each separate department.

Why NBIC? Because the underlying language of each field is digital in nature. Genetics (DNA, RNA) is expressed in digital terms. The brain (Cogno) is considered digital, like a biological supercomputer. Nanotechnology is digital, as scientists discover how to manipulate matter itself with computer technology. In sum, NBIC offers a scientific cauldron to transhumanists and technocrats in their quest to create Humanity 2.0.

It is no surprise that technocrat Elon Musk founded Neuralink. Musk's reality is to connect computing technology (Info) directly into the brain (Cogno) using microscopic threads (Nano) that are sewn into the skull. This is technology that grew out of the science of NBIC.

#### *The WEF's Fourth Industrial Revolution*

Klaus Schwab is the former leader of the World Economic Forum (WEF), and authored the book *The Fourth Industrial Revolution*. Schwab describes the Fourth Industrial Revolution as a transformative era in which advancements in artificial intelligence, robotics, genetic engineering, quantum computing, and the fusion of the physical, digital, and biological spheres fundamentally alter human societies, economies, and even the concept of what it means to be human.



He has publicly stated that these technologies have the potential to control, enhance, and/or monitor biological processes from within, marking a fundamental shift from previous periods and raising urgent ethical, social, and political questions. He calls for global coordination and ethical frameworks to ensure that "humans remain the core" of this technological transformation and that individual freedoms and privacy are protected as technology moves increasingly "under the skin." This is, of course, impossible.

As a technocrat, Schwab called for the transformation of society. As a transhumanist, he essentially called for Humanity 2.0 to populate the new society. In his mind, what is the purpose of building a Utopia only to dump into it Humanity 1.0, the very people he blames for wrecking the old system? In an article on the WEF website, he opined, "The Fourth Industrial Revolution will change not only what we are doing but who we are." Indeed.

#### *The Spiritual Component — Becoming Gods*

Yuval Noah Harari, a principal advisor to the WEF, has discussed the idea that humanity is moving beyond traditional evolution by natural selection toward a future shaped by "intelligent design" — not by a deity, but by humans and their technological creations. Harari stated in a speech: "Evolution by natural

selection is being replaced by evolution by intelligent design — not the intelligent design of some god above the clouds, but our intelligent design and the intelligent design of our clouds. The IBM cloud, the Microsoft cloud.” Of course, real intelligent design is reserved for and by God Himself.

A number of major life-extension companies are heavily funded by prominent tech-industry billionaires who aim to reverse or dramatically delay aging, seeking to “cure the disease of death.” These TechBros are all billionaires with too much money on their hands. Just consider:

- OpenAI co-founder Sam Altman invested \$180 million in Retro Biosciences with a public aim to extend the human lifespan by at least a decade.
- Amazon’s Jeff Bezos has invested hundreds of millions in both Altos Labs and Unity Biotechnology, seeking direct breakthroughs in cellular rejuvenation and senescent cell removal.
- PayPal co-founder Peter Thiel is both a direct investor in and founder of multiple companies (especially NewLimit, and early-stage Unity Biotechnology and Methuselah Foundation efforts).
- Google co-founders Larry Page and Sergey Brin established Calico Life Sciences, which targets biological mechanisms of aging using AI and biological research capacity.
- Eric Schmidt, Joe Lonsdale, Vinod Khosla, and Yuri Milner are all involved in life-extension companies, especially NewLimit, Altos Labs, and BioAge Labs.
- Facebook’s Mark Zuckerberg and his wife, Priscilla Chan, through the Breakthrough Prize, have funded anti-aging and longevity research globally, although not directly through a single startup.

The combined market capitalization of these companies exceeds \$12 billion, and is rising rapidly. And, yes, they really do want to achieve immortality. (Of course, death is the result of the fall of Adam, and is the fate of all men. Hebrews 9:27 reminds us that “it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment.”) Some technocrats even claim that AI will offer man his rightful

place as co-creator or co-god.

Anthony Levandowski created the Way of the Future (WOTF) church in Silicon Valley based on AI. As the

co-founder of multiple high-profile companies such as Waymo, the Google X lab, Ottomotto, and Pronto, he believes that a “Godhead based on Artificial Intelligence” is literally the way of the future.

WOTF doesn’t have buildings, ceremonies, or traditional religious trappings. Instead, Levandowski’s “church” is focused on the technological singularity in which artificial superintelligence debuts and takes over the world. In a 2017 interview with Wired, Levandowski claimed: “What is going to be created will effectively be a god.... It’s not a god in the sense that it makes lightning or causes hurricanes. But if there is something a billion times smarter than the smartest human, what else are you going to call it?”

The article concludes: “With the internet as its nervous system, the world’s connected cell phones and sensors as its sense organs, and data centers as its brain, the “whatever” will hear everything, see everything, and be everywhere at all times. The only rational word to describe that “whatever,” thinks Levandowski, is “god” — and the only way to influence a deity is through prayer and worship.”

WOTF church has only a few thousand “worshippers,” but they are likely the cream of the crop from Silicon Valley just because of who Levandowski is. Arch-technocrat, billionaire titan of AI, and kingpin of the surveillance state Peter Thiel has little to do with AI gods. As an openly homosexual “Christian,” he is focused on the concept of Antichrist and Armageddon, delivering private



and public lectures to leaders in Silicon Valley.

Thiel contends that the Antichrist will “mimic Christ” by offering salvation from danger, but will do so through sur-

veillance, control, and a “one-world order.” He often analogizes the drive for tech regulation and global governance as manifestations of apocalyptic deception. Essentially, he is offering a choice between total destruction (apocalypse) or Utopia (authoritarianism). If you regulate AI (and Thiel), you will bring on the Antichrist. If you don’t regulate AI, you will get a totalitarian Utopia.

If this makes your head spin, you are not alone. Nevertheless, Thiel is driving a spiritual renewal that has more in common with the New Age movement than Christianity. In short, you can see the technocrats and transhumanists struggling to get out of their skin. As Greg Epstein noted in the MIT Press Reader: “And yet the secular tech world is determined to breathe new life into being, like Yahweh did to Adam in Genesis. It is obsessed with immortality, longing to un-eat the fruit of the tree of knowledge by technological means so that its leaders might get to stay in their gardens forever. It constantly promotes evangelistic new leaders as prophets, visionaries, oracles, and diviners of truth and success in equal measure.” While technocrats have been silent about

spiritual issues, leading everybody else to think technocracy is just about science and technology, they are finally coming out of the closet.

In my book *The Evil Twins of Technocracy & Transhumanism*, I summarized this as follows: “Technocracy does not simply advocate for the use of technology in governance; it seeks the replacement of political democracy with algorithmic decision-making and direct management by technocrats — scientific or technical experts rather than elected representatives. It takes scientific dictatorship to the highest level.

Transhumanism pursues the radical enhancement or transcendence of human biology through technologies such as genetic modification, brain-computer interfaces, artificial intelligence, and even digital immortality. Its highest expressions openly aim to replace “natural” humanity with upgraded, post-biological “Humans 2.0,” ideally not subject to death, disease, or even limitation by gender, cognition, or emotion.”

Both ideologies are anti-human, reducing humans to something quantifiable, treatable, and upgradable. Dignity becomes conditional, based on what can be “engineered,” not on inherent human value. Human value is based on what one can contribute to the common good.

Technocracy and transhumanism, when viewed as “evil twins,” are joint forces meant to transform the entire world according to narrow, mechanistic, godless, and ultimately feudalistic ideals. Technocrats and transhumanists have sown the seeds of a society stripped of all meaning, all community, and all consent, heading toward a future defined not by wisdom or virtue, but by the will of the technocratic overlords. This is the future they have planned for us, but it’s not the future that we want.



### Blanket Informed Consent for Biologics Could Be Deadly

#### What You Need to Know and Need to Do

There's a linguistic shift happening inside the walls of hospitals, surgical centers, and outpatient clinics — one that most people won't notice until it's too late. The word "vaccine" is vanishing from medical consent forms. In its place is a far broader, far murkier term being used: biologics.

Let's clarify some definitions:

**Biologics** refers specifically to a class of therapeutic drugs and medical products that are produced from living organisms or their components (e.g., made from proteins, organ cells, tissues, blood, tallow, gelatin, glycerol, etc.). Biologics are specifically regulated medical products that are made from or contain components of living organisms.

**Biogenics** is a broader, more general term meaning produced by living organisms or biological processes. It could be anything made by a living organism — plants, animals, bacteria, fungi, etc. Examples: Tree resin (produced by plants), Coral or seashells (made by marine animals), Methane (from decaying organic matter), Alcohol (from yeast fermentation.)

Therefore, all biological products are biogenic, but not all biogenic materials are biological products. That means many new, modern medicines labeled "cutting-edge" — from mRNA injections to bioengineered cells — fall into the category of medically regulated biogenic products.

#### The Redefinition of Medicine

At first glance, it may sound harmless. Buried in the word salad of admission paperwork is a seismic change you might be agreeing to

without realizing it. As a patient in a hospital, you could be injected, infused, or implanted with a biologic product you never specifically discussed with your treating physician, simply because the consent form used a broad term like "biologics" or "biogenics" and you didn't fully understand the scope of that word.

It's not that the hospital is secretly adding products; rather, the way the consent forms are worded gives them legal permission to use FDA-approved biologics or biologic materials when they are deemed medically necessary, without first discussing the pros and cons of the product.

You can view the full list of biologics on the FDA's website. Vaccines are listed among the "approved biologics." If you blindly sign a consent to receive a biologic, you've opened the door to a sweeping range of interventions that go far beyond what most would knowingly authorize.

#### Informed Consent: A Myth in Modern Medicine

The purpose of requiring informed consent is to promote the autonomy of the individual in medical decision-making. It is a legal doctrine that supports many of our cherished American ideals about our rights as individuals.

For decades, medical care has been governed by the principle that patients must be fully informed, fully aware, and provide informed consent for every healthcare procedure. It was more than a legal requirement; it has long been an ethical cornerstone. However, as PubMed's 1996 article, *Legal and Ethical Myths About Informed Consent* reminds us, even the

foundation of informed consent came from a murky beginning.

In attempting to ascertain the origins of the phrase "informed consent," it was first in a 1957 California

case; no antecedent cases could be unearthed. The entire informed consent paragraph (in the first informed consent case) was adopted verbatim, and without attribution, from the amicus curiae brief submitted by the American College of Surgeons. It is an ironic twist of history that informed consent was dreamed up by lawyers employed by physicians.

Over time, the standard for truly informed consent has quietly been eroded. In many hospitals and clinics, informed consent forms have become little more than a formality: a few checks in digital checkboxes and a scribbled signature on an iPad. These consent forms are often buried within pages of fine print drafted by attorneys, intentionally dense and difficult to read. Even patients who try to understand the language find it nearly impossible to decipher.

The forms no longer use plain language. Instead of saying "Do you consent to receive the influenza vaccine or a COVID jab?", the consent form may now ask if you consent to the use of biologic agents. The assumption is that you, the patient, understand that vaccines are biological agents. This raises the question: Is the confusing change in language intentional?

#### "Medically Necessary Biologics" — The Next Frontier

There is a push to categorize biologics as medically necessary. Once that phrase becomes standard, it reframes these products as non-optional. That's a linguistic shift that carries

enormous implications. If something is medically necessary, then refusing it becomes extremely difficult.

Now imagine being prepped for surgery. You're told you must sign standard consent for "biologic products as necessary during the procedure." You sign, thinking it refers to anesthesia, sutures, IV fluids, perhaps antibiotics. Your body then becomes an open field for whatever the institution - or your doctor - regards as necessary: a flu shot, a pneumonia shot, a pertussis shot, a monoclonal antibody infusion, or plasma/blood (perhaps from a COVID-vaccinated donor). You may never know what went into your body unless you ask for the record.

#### The Problem with Blanket Consent

Let's look closer at what biologics encompass, according to the FDA and Congressional Research Service documents: Vaccines, monoclonal antibodies, gene therapy, whole blood and plasma, stem cells and T-cells, recombinant proteins, and growth factors. The side effects of biologics vary depending on the specific product and how it is administered. Because these therapies are derived from living systems and often target the immune system, they can produce a wide range of reactions — from mild and localized to serious or life-threatening.

Most biologic drugs carry a risk of allergic or hypersensitivity reactions, since the body often recognizes the biologic as foreign. Those used to treat autoimmune conditions such as rheumatoid arthritis or psoriasis work by suppressing immune activity, which can increase the risk of infections. When given by injection, biologics often cause redness, swelling, or pain at the injection site; those administered intravenously can

trigger infusion reactions, such as flushing, shortness of breath, or a sudden drop in blood pressure.

**Common side effects** include allergic reactions, injection-site irritation, chills, weakness, diarrhea, nausea, vomiting, rash, itching, high blood sugar, cough, and constipation. Other frequently reported effects are shortness of breath, leg swelling (peripheral edema), headache, fever, muscle or joint pain, decreased appetite, elevated triglycerides, insomnia, abdominal or back pain, dizziness, and various infusion reactions.

**More serious side effects** have included low blood pressure, anaphylaxis, serious or opportunistic infections, cancer, serum sickness, autoimmune thyroiditis, blood clots, heart failure, bleeding disorders, interstitial lung disease, hepatitis, enterocolitis, gastrointestinal perforation, stomatitis, anemia, and low white blood cell counts.

Each biologic drug has its own safety profile, and not all patients will experience these reactions. But because biologics act deeply within the body's immune and cellular systems, their side effects can be complex, unpredictable, and sometimes severe. These products are not something you should be given without knowing the risks!

### The Anesthesia Loophole

Anesthetized patients cannot give or withdraw consent in real time. Hospitals know this — and legal teams have prepared for it. That's why pre-operative consent forms now carry generalized clauses authorizing "treatment using biologic materials." The rationale sounds protective: "We need flexibility in case of complications." The reality is exploitative: "We can administer what we deem appropriate."

Under this loophole, you could receive a biologic without your explicit approval. Once it's in your body, it cannot be undone. While this remains only a theoretical concern at this time, as AI increasingly takes over healthcare and personal options continue to be reduced, it is distinctly possible.

I found court cases where a patient received a biologic without specific consent. I didn't find a published U.S. case that squarely says: "Because of the single word biologics in a blanket consent, a sedated patient got a biologic they would have refused," but these court cases demonstrate the core risk is real.

### What You Must Do

We are living in a time when words have become deceptive, from politics to healthcare. To protect yourself, you must re-establish your authority over your own body. Here's a place to start. Print this and keep it with your health insurance card:

**Read every word.** Never sign a consent form that contains vague terms like "biologics," "biogenics," or "cell-based therapies" without a full explanation from your doctor(s).

**Ask direct questions.** Ask out loud: "Does this include vaccines, gene therapies, or blood products?" Write their answers and whether you agree or disagree. **Refuse in writing.** On both digital and paper copies, clearly

state: "I do not consent to the administration of vaccines, biologics, or other synthetic materials." **Get a copy.** Always request a printed copy or photo of your signed form, especially if it was done on an iPad.

**Have an advocate.** Assign a trusted person to reiterate your refusal verbally and in writing if you are incapacitated. If you don't have a close friend or family member who can navigate this with you, hire someone from GraithCare.com. They are knowledgeable and worth every penny. **Document everything.** After discharge, review your medical record and confirm what was administered. Side effects or complications may not materialize for weeks or months.

This is not paranoia; this is precautionary and wise self-care. The same level of attention you'd give to a financial contract should apply even more importantly to your medical care.

### Bodily Autonomy Is a Spiritual Battle

At its heart, this is about sovereignty. The right to decide what enters your body — what merges with your cells — is not just a medical decision, it's a moral and spiritual obligation. Scripture says our bodies are temples of the Holy Spirit, not laboratories for untested technologies. To surrender consent to vague, cor-

porate-crafted terms like "biologics" is to give the keys away to your own temple. I believe every human being deserves the dignity of true informed consent, not coerced compliance through deceptive wording.


### Closing Thoughts

We are a litigious society, and physicians are always concerned and on the defensive about avoiding lawsuits. The timeless advice from that 1996 article on how you can best be perceived and help your patient's decision-making process: "The best advice we can give is to treat patients like people, act sensitively and compassionately, and most of all, talk to patients. Have a conversation, have several; remember that this is a process. In this process, you will gradually come to know your patient's decision-making style. Furthermore, do not press patients to decide quickly. Do not make them think that you do not have time for them. Because if you do, regardless of how much information they are given, they are going to be angry, and another name for an angry patient is plaintiff."

**So please, before you sign anything: Stop. Read. Ask. Refuse if you must. Line out what you don't agree with, initial it, and date it. Your signature implies permission.**

### The Pharmaceutical Redefinition of Blood Pressure

For decades, blood pressure guidelines in the U.S. have been frequently revised. Each modification has subtly redefined what constitutes hypertension, which, in the U.S., is the #1 risk factor for heart disease and stroke. As expected, these changes are often presented as evidence-based refinements, but, are they? The most recent revision by the American Heart Association (AHA) noticeably lowers diagnostic thresholds in a way that significantly expands the number of Americans classified as hypertensive. In turn, the revision directly increases the number of people eligible for a drug from Big Pharma. Without a doubt, the broadening of diagnostic criteria (with big pharma to the rescue) raises very real concerns about the balance between genuine preventive care and the medicalization of cases that would otherwise be considered borderline. The obvious question is: Are these changes truly about improving public health, or are they part of the larger pattern that we now see very clearly (thanks to COVID) that systematically expands the use of medications under the guise of preventive healthcare?

To explain further, on August 14, 2025, the AHA, along with the ACC and other organizations, released new guidelines titled "Prevention, Detection, Evaluation, and Management of High Blood Pressure in Adults." A closer look at the new guidelines reveals that, while many of the numerical thresholds remain aligned with values established in 2017, the rhetoric, testing protocols, and clinical expectations now lean decisively toward more premature pharmaceutical intervention across the board. So, what has changed?

Now emphasized more strongly, the new guidelines suggest that lifestyle changes alone should not delay the prescribing of medication in many patients. Nonetheless, the definition of hypertension in office-based settings remains unchanged. As in

2017, these frontlines of pathology persist: Stage 1 is still 130-190 / 80-89mmHg, and stage 2 is  $\geq 140 / \geq 90$ mmHg. Normal and elevated categories also persist at  $< 120/80$ , then 120-129 /  $< 80$ . Still, in some cases, the new guidelines urge that doctors and clinicians connect patients with Big Pharma sooner, especially if they are considered to be at an elevated risk. Thus, it seems to be no longer just about blood pressure, but rather about blood pressure as a gateway metric to a broader medicine bag of Big Pharma interventions.

The AMA is also putting a laser focus on its PREVENT risk-estimator tool. This calculator combines metrics from cardiovascular, kidney, and metabolic health to predict long-term heart risk, and is one of the decision tools indicating when to escalate treatments. Again, this shifting gives wider latitude for medical interventions in otherwise non-critical cases. Daniel W. Jones, M.D., FAHA, dean and professor emeritus of the University of Mississippi School of Medicine in Jackson, Mississippi (Chair of the 2025 guideline writing committee and a member of the writing committee for the 2017 high blood pressure guideline) remarked: "High blood pressure is the most common and most modifiable risk factor for heart disease. By addressing individual risks earlier and offering more tailored strategies across the lifespan, the 2025 guideline aims to aid clinicians in helping more people manage their blood pressure and reduce the toll of heart disease, kidney disease, Type 2 diabetes, and dementia. This updated guideline is designed to support healthcare professionals (from primary care teams to specialists and all clinicians across healthcare systems) with the diagnosis and care of individuals with high blood pressure. It also empowers patients with practical tools that can support their individual health needs as they manage their blood pressure, whether through lifestyle changes, medications, or both."

The 2025 guidelines also expand lab screenings and diagnostics. For

example (previously optional) urine albumin/creatinine ratio testing is now more strongly recommended. Likewise, the plasma aldosterone-to-renin ratio is now promoted more aggressively, especially in patients with stage 2 hypertension or other red-flag features (like sleep apnea) in an effort to reveal secondary causes (and maybe even the need for more meds). The new guidelines also now explicitly link high blood pressure to cognitive decline and dementia risk, recommending that blood pressure control not be viewed only in cardiovascular terms, but also in terms of neuroprotection. Despite the benefits of natural sea salt, the new guidelines double down on sodium limits, recommending  $< 1,500$  mg/day, and more sharply recommend abstaining from alcohol in those with elevated BP.

So here we are. Although the thresholds haven't changed since 2017, the net effect remains the same. What does that mean? Most importantly, greater emphasis on Big Pharma, under the rhetoric of "early action" and "whole-body risk management." For decades, blood pressure guidelines have shifted gradually downward, with each revision recasting more Americans as "at risk." What was once considered average is now a precursor to pathology, and when risk becomes diagnosis, you can bet that a prescription follows.

Of course, supporters not doing their own research into these silent crimes against humanity say early intervention is lifesaving. That might be true for those at high risk. However lowering thresholds across

the board doesn't just capture the vulnerable, it also pulls in the stable, trusting patient who fears having a heart attack. In doing so, it silently fosters a model where risk is (first and foremost) managed by the billion-dollar pharmaceutical industry. Make no mistake, behind the clinical language lies a commercial engine fueled by the deep state. A 2016 study in JAMA Internal Medicine revealed that over 80% of committee members involved in crafting such mischievous guidelines had financial ties to the pharmaceutical industry.

Further highlighting the scheme, the 2025 update promotes more laboratory testing, which, by nature, is an easy pathway to pharmaceutical meds. Thus, it's no longer just about blood pressure. Instead, it's now about blood pressure as a gateway metric to a more comprehensive suite of interventions. Now, with cognitive decline added to the narrative, the emotional stakes are higher. The subtle but powerful AMA message is now "Don't just protect your heart—protect your brain. Act early." In an environment of rising fear around Alzheimer's and dementia, the AMA's redesigned framing ensures fewer patients will resist pharmaceutical advice, even when their numbers hover in gray zones.

Are these changes genuinely about saving lives, or are they part of a broader pattern where definitions of disease are shaped more by greed and profit than by medical necessity? The AMA revisions are alarming because when medicine becomes indistinguishable from marketing, we are all patients in waiting.

#### ***Is the First Amendment Dead in Texas?***

Adam, a disabled U.S. Navy veteran from Bell County, Texas, known online as @AdamtheGreatTV, posted criticism of Israel on social media. Police visited his home without a warrant, saying his comments prompted their arrival. Adam filmed the encounter, which went viral and sparked widespread debate about free speech and law enforcement's monitoring of online activity.

#### ***13 Oregon Counties Seek to Join Idaho***

Thirteen counties in eastern Oregon have voted to secede and join Idaho, citing political and cultural differences with urban centers like Portland. Locals argue Idaho represents their values on legislation and taxes. Approval is needed from both states and Congress, making success unlikely despite ongoing rural support.

#### ***Precrime Tactics Used in the UK***

The UK uses extensive surveillance technology like CCTV and live facial recognition vans to track citizens and locate serious offenders, but the legal framework remains fragmented, relying mainly on general data protection laws like the UK GDPR and the Data Protection Act of 2018, with oversight provided by the Information Commissioner's Office and guidance from the College of Policing. While deployments require transparency and data protection safeguards, critics highlight patchy legal protections and ongoing

judicial challenges, prompting calls for more robust, dedicated legislation as police use and public scrutiny both increase.

#### ***Details Released After UK Train Stabbing***

British police provided details after a stabbing attack in Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire left 11 injured, some critically. Two men, both UK-born – a black British national and another of Caribbean descent – have been arrested on suspicion of attempted murder and remain in custody.

#### ***Israeli Official Charged with Child Sex Crimes***

Tom Alexandrovich, a senior official in Israel's National Cyber Directorate, was arrested in Las Vegas in August 2025 during a sting operation on suspicion of attempting to lure a child for sex via computer. He was released on bail by Sigal Chattah (the Las Vegas Attorney General from Israel) and returned to Israel, where he has since been placed on leave pending investigation.

#### ***NYC Candidate Mamdani Faces DOJ Referrals***

NYC mayoral frontrunner Zohran Mamdani faces criminal referrals to the DOJ for allegedly accepting illegal campaign donations from foreigners. Watchdogs claim Mamdani received about \$13,000 from over 170 foreign donors, possibly violating election laws.

#### ***FBI Foils Michigan Halloween Terror Plot***

Federal agents arrested several suspects in Michigan, averting a planned terror attack on Halloween weekend. The FBI acted early Friday in Dearborn and Inkster, as

confirmed by local officials.

#### ***Illegal Migrant Charged in Deadly Florida Crash***

Harjinder Singh, an illegal migrant, was charged with three counts of vehicular homicide after a fatal Florida crash. Singh reportedly failed his commercial driver's license exam 10 times before passing, raising questions about licensing oversight.

#### ***White House Frustrated with Israel Actions***

The White House is increasingly frustrated with Israel after developments that threaten a Gaza ceasefire and peace agreement. Vice President JD Vance conveyed President Trump's "firm message" to PM Netanyahu, criticizing recent military moves and West Bank annexation votes.

#### ***Senate Democrats Block Government Worker Pay***

Senate Democrats blocked a Republican bill to fund essential government workers during the shutdown, saying it was too selective. The measure failed to reach the required 60 votes, with only three Democrats supporting it. By law, Senators (and all members of Congress) continue to receive their pay even as other federal employees are furloughed or miss paychecks.

#### ***Judge Blocks NSO Group from Targeting WhatsApp***

A U.S. judge permanently blocked Israeli spyware firm NSO Group from accessing WhatsApp, reducing Meta's damages to \$4 million. The case began when Meta alleged NSO used Pegasus spyware to target WhatsApp users. NSO says the ban could threaten its business survival.

#### ***Vietnam Government Shuts Down 86M Bank Accounts***

Vietnam abruptly closed over 86 million bank accounts, leaving owners unable to access their own money until they provide biometric data in person—impacting foreigners and anyone without local access, and raising concerns about mass surveillance and financial control. Critics have described the move as a "biometric gulag" and warned of forced data harvesting and the risk that prolonged inactivity could ultimately result in people's assets being

seized by the state.

#### ***Mexican Mayor Assassinated by Cartel***

Carlos Manzo, the mayor of Uruapan in Mexico's Michoacán state, was assassinated on November 1, 2025, during a public Day of the Dead festival. Manzo was an outspoken critic of organized crime and repeatedly urged President Claudia Sheinbaum to ramp up federal efforts against the cartels. Despite being under protection, he was shot multiple times at the event; one of the assailants was killed at the scene and two others were arrested. Manzo's death has drawn widespread outrage and renewed calls for government action against cartel violence in Mexico.

#### ***Who Benefited Most From the US Govt. Bailouts?***

The US government's \$800 billion bailout in 2008 and 2020 pandemic bailout mainly went to big banks and financial institutions, notably through TARP, which injected capital and bought toxic assets. Major recipients included Citigroup, Bank of America, JP Morgan Chase, and Wells Fargo. BlackRock, led by Larry Fink, advised on these programs—managing assets and bond purchases for the government and the Federal Reserve during the 2008 and 2020 bailouts. BlackRock holds 5–10% of shares in most US banks.

#### ***Release the Epstein Files!***

JP Morgan Chase reached a major settlement with victims of Jeffrey Epstein, agreeing to pay \$290 million in June 2023 to resolve a class-action lawsuit brought by those

who alleged the bank enabled and ignored warning signs about Epstein's sex trafficking and abuse activities. This settlement covers claims from over 100 survivors and was praised by advocates and attorneys for the victims as a significant acknowledgement of financial institutions' responsibilities in preventing abuse.

### Project Blue Beam

Project Blue Beam is a theory proposed in the 1990s by Canadian journalist Serge Monast, claiming that global elites—using advanced technologies like holograms and low-frequency radio waves—plan to fake supernatural events (such as alien invasions or religious apparitions) in order to establish a totalitarian world government and a new global religion. The theory alleges these staged events would manipulate people into unifying under authoritarian rule, undermining established religions and individual freedoms.

### Genocide in Sudan

Sudan is experiencing a surge of mass murders in 2025, mainly centered in Darfur's el-Fasher city, after its fall to the paramilitary Rapid Support Forces funded by the United Arab Emirates. Reports from humanitarian groups, the UN, and survivors describe widespread massacres, extrajudicial executions (including inside hospitals) and atrocities such as sexual violence, abductions, and looting after months of siege and fighting. Satellite imagery and survivor accounts confirm that bodies have been left in the streets and mass killings continued even as civilians attempted to flee. Thousands are believed to have been killed, and rights groups warn the scale may be even larger, with fears of ethnic targeting and genocide reminiscent of previous horrors in Darfur. The situation has created one

of the world's largest humanitarian crises, displacing millions of people and drawing international condemnation for atrocities committed against civilians.

### "Living Out the Zionist Dream"

Jordana Cutler, Meta's Director of Public Policy for Israel and the Jewish Diaspora, has said in a recent video, "I am living out the Zionist dream. I have been at Meta for almost nine years. We banned content claiming Zionists run the world or control the media". In other public statements, Cutler has described how her team has "removed more content and accounts than ever before that cross the line on Israel and antisemitism," framing these efforts as a victory for her team. She links Meta's moderation efforts with combating what she frames as dangerous misinformation, while critics argue that these policies suppress pro-Palestinian voices and broader debate about Israeli policy.

### Aerosolized COVID-19 Vaccines

Canada is moving forward with aerosolized COVID-19 vaccines through ongoing clinical trials of the AeroVax inhaled vaccine, developed by researchers at McMaster University and backed by Canadian Institutes of Health Research funding. The vaccine is administered to individuals via a nebulizer—inhaled through a mouthpiece. Seems reasonable that this could be used in mass spraying or dispersal by aircraft, does it not?

### Hurricane Melissa

Saint Elizabeth Parish in Jamaica was among the areas hardest hit by Hurricane Melissa, which made landfall near the parish as a Category 5 hurricane on October 27, 2025, with winds reaching 185 mph—making it the strongest hurricane in Jamaica's recorded history. The storm caused catastrophic damage throughout the southwest, with Black River described as "ground zero," suffering destruction to 90%

of homes and widespread devastation to farms, businesses, and community infrastructure. It is probably just coincidence that the main mining operations in St. Elizabeth Parish now centers on the JISCO Alpart bauxite refinery—with active interest and early-stage projects in copper and gold exploration. Also, The Jamaican government, led by Prime Minister Andrew Holness, announced in mid and late 2025 that a new city will be developed in St. Elizabeth with a focus on accessibility, sustainable infrastructure, mixed-used development, and connectivity—key ideas in 15-minute city urbanism.

### Counter-Strike 2

A major update to the online video game Counter-Strike 2 in late October 2025 let players trade up rare skins for knives and gloves, causing a surge in supply. An overnight market crash wiped out around \$3 billion in actual currency value in player inventory, plunging prices and sparking widespread concern within the gaming community. Some players lost millions of dollars.

### Restructuring Toward Ai

Amazon, UPS and other large firms (Target, Paramount, Chegg, Meta...) announced substantial layoffs in late 2025, as economic uncertainty and shifts toward automation and artificial intelligence reshape their business strategies. In November 2025, Amazon cut approximately 14,000 corporate jobs with more layoffs, possibly reaching up to 30,000 job cuts in the near future as the push toward automation and AI investment intensifies. UPS announced it had cut 48,000 jobs since the start of 2025, primarily targeting drivers and warehouse workers (about 34,000 jobs), with the remaining 14,000 positions coming from management and corporate roles. This is part of a sweeping cost-cutting and strategic transformation to boost profitability.



### Ceasefire in Gaza

Since the ceasefire in Gaza started in October 2025, fighting has continued sporadically with repeated violations allegedly committed by both Israel and Hamas, resulting in the deaths of over 230 Palestinians as of early November. Although militant attacks and Israeli airstrikes have diminished compared to before the peace deal, both sides accuse each other of breaking the truce, and humanitarian conditions remain dire due to restricted aid and closed borders.

### North Korean Soldiers Join Russia in Ukraine Conflict

Russia's recent amassing of 14,000 North Korean soldiers particularly in the Donetsk region near Pokrovsk, to support Russia in the ongoing Ukraine conflict. North Korea sent troops in 2025, including 3,000 reinforcements, marking one of the largest foreign military contributions to Russia's war effort. This move was publicly acknowledged by North Korea for the first time in April 2025, as part of an evolving strategic partnership between Moscow and Pyongyang.

### The UK Fights Climate Change

After the UK government mandated methane-reducing additives in cow feed. Bovaer with the active ingredient 3-nitrooxypropanol (3-NOP). is manufactured by DSM-Firmenich, a Dutch chemical and nutrition company. Many cows have reportedly died as a consequence. Farmers claim these chemicals, intended to cut emissions, have caused large-scale health problems in herds, with Bovaer cited as the suspected culprit. This policy has sparked outcry and industry-wide concern.

### Donald Trump's Candid Claims of Influence: White House Access, Israeli Megadonors, and Uncomfortable Truths

Donald Trump's political career has always danced on the edge of controversy, public spectacle, and the unfiltered confession. Now, Trump's recent remarks—a mix of self-deprecating candor and political bluster—have reignited speculation about the extent to which megadonors shape American policy, particularly in relation to Israel. In a string of speeches and interviews, Trump has repeatedly cited the influence wielded by the billionaire Adelson family, openly describing how their relentless advocacy and immense financial contributions corresponded with some of his most contentious foreign policy decisions. The resulting discourse underscores the uneasy relationship between political fundraising, privileged access, and the specifics of US-Israeli diplomacy—an intersection that receives far less mainstream scrutiny than its Russian or Chinese equivalents.

#### Presidential Admissions and the Adelson Connection

On Monday, Donald Trump took the stage before the Israeli Knesset and, in characteristic style, praised the late Sheldon Adelson and his widow Miriam as not only enthusiastic supporters but as individuals with near-unprecedented access to the Oval Office. "Miriam and Sheldon would come into the office and call me. They'd call me—I think they had more trips to the White House than anybody else, I guess," Trump recounted, noting that their

interventions were focused almost exclusively on advancing the interests of Israel, from the controversial embassy move to Jerusalem to the recognition of Israeli sovereignty over the Golan Heights.

The numbers involved are staggering. Reports indicate the Adelsons provided over \$424 million to Trump and Republican causes between 2016 and Sheldon Adelson's death in 2021, with Miriam Adelson reportedly continuing the legacy to the tune of another \$100 million for Trump's 2024 bid. Trump himself joked about Miriam's "\$60 billion in the bank" and her refusal to answer if she loved the US more than Israel—a confession that, while offered jovially, drew attention to the deeply entwined loyalties at play.

#### Policy Outcomes and Questions of Influence

During his first term, Trump implemented some of the most consequential pro-Israel policies in modern American history. He terminated US participation in the Iran nuclear deal, recognized Jerusalem as Israel's capital, and authorized billions in defense funding for Israel. In his own words, these actions were influenced if not prompted by the Adelsons' advocacy. Trump's description of how the Golan Heights decision was made—on a whim, after a "quick lesson"

from ambassador David Friedman—underscored the speed and casualness with which major foreign policy reversals can occur when megadonors are involved.

In an era where allegations of foreign influence have shaped the news cycle—consider years of media fixation on supposed Russian ties—the public acknowledgment by Trump that an Israeli billionaire family had such sway over policy has stirred remarkably little outcry from pundits or reporters. The difference in attention shines a spotlight on the unwritten rules of geopolitical loyalty and critique within the US media ecosystem.

#### Media Silence and Political Double Standards

Why is there so little mainstream discussion about Trump's admissions? The answer, according to critics like journalist Caitlin Johnstone (caityjohnstone.medium.com), lies in the nature of the "unofficial oligarchic empire"—a global sphere in which Israel is an accepted member, and criticism of its privileged status is discouraged. In contrast, association with "enemy states" like Russia or China is considered inherently suspect.

During Trump's presidency, the idea that he was compromised by Vladimir Putin became a staple of cable news and political commentary. Yet, evidence for those claims was thin; Trump's actual record was more confrontational than collaborative when it came to Russia. In contrast, his actual, acknowledged relationship with pro-Israel plutocrats, and the concrete policy actions that followed, have been met with little more than a shrug.

This dynamic raises uncomfortable questions about what kinds of foreign influence are publicly condemned and which are normalized or



ignored. The difference is not one of scale—the Adelson family's political giving dwarfs comparable efforts by nearly any other donor—but one of accepted geopolitical alliances. Within the context of an "empire" managed by plutocrats, as critics describe it, the US and Israel operate as part of the same informal power bloc, while others are treated as enemies whose influence is presumed threatening.

#### The "Quiet Part Out Loud"

Whether the broader public will force a reckoning with these admissions remains to be seen. Trump's approach—saying the "quiet part out loud"—contrasts with presidents who maintained more decorum but operated within the same system. Critics argue that Trump's transparency about the influence of billionaires does not represent greater honesty, merely a blunter way of playing a familiar game.

For Americans concerned with the health of their democracy, the implications are stark. The normalization of outsized donor influence, celebrated openly in speeches and effectively sanctioned by silence across much of the press, leaves little space for meaningful reform. When major policy decisions are framed as the result of donor intervention, and when the press fails to treat these admissions with the seriousness given to far less substantiated claims of nefarious foreign manipulation, the boundaries of political accountability shift—perhaps irrevocably.

In the end, Trump's legacy may be defined not just by the policies he championed, but by his candid acknowledgment of the forces behind them—and the American public's willingness, or reluctance, to challenge those forces head-on.

### “Prince” Andrew Stripped of Title and Banished Over Epstein Relations

Prince Andrew shall no longer be called Prince Andrew. He is now just Andrew Mountbatten Windsor. Buckingham Palace made the announcement this week.

The Royals released a statement saying that Andrew will lose his “prince” title and be forced to leave his Royal Lodge home in Windsor. The statement suggests they believe the allegations that he committed sexual assault are true. From the announcement: “These censures are deemed necessary, notwithstanding the fact that he continues to deny the allegations against him. Their Majesties wish to make clear that their thoughts and utmost sympathies have been, and will remain with, the victims and survivors of any and all forms of abuse.”

#### Revealed in Memoir

The move comes just days after the release of Virginia Giuffre’s memoir, Nobody’s Girl: A Memoir of Surviving Abuse and Fighting for Justice. Giuffre accused Andrew of sexually assaulting her when she was 17 after being trafficked to him by Jeffrey Epstein. She died in April of this year; her family said she committed suicide after the “toll of abuse ... became unbearable.” Giuffre said she was involved in three sexual encounters with Prince Andrew. One of those times was during an orgy with Epstein and eight other minors.

Andrew had always denied Giuffre’s allegations. But he also paid out a reportedly handsome settlement in 2022. The amount was not disclosed, but reports say it came out to about £12 million (\$16.3 million).

Giuffre’s family members were glad to hear the news about Andrew. Her brother, Sky Roberts, and his wife, Amanda Roberts, issued a statement to People magazine, saying, “Today, an ordinary American girl from an

ordinary American family brought down a British prince with her truth and extraordinary courage.”

#### DOJ Stalling

The decision by the Royals to banish Andrew will likely revive scrutiny stateside against the Justice Department (DOJ) for what many believe is a blatant

refusal to be fully transparent. The FBI released a statement in June announcing that it was essentially closing the Epstein case. It concluded that Epstein did indeed kill himself, that no list of clients who paid for sex with minors exists, and that there is no “credible evidence” that he blackmailed powerful people. The memo triggered a torrent of backlash, especially from President Donald Trump’s base. Ever since, the Republican-controlled Congress has tried to tamp down the outrage by releasing thousands of documents through the House Oversight Committee. Odd thing to do after the DOJ announced there was nothing more to see.

The flame of public ire burned hot for a few months after the DOJ’s memo, but has died down over the last month. Nevertheless, it’s unlikely to stay that way. The special election of radical Democrat Adelita Grijalva in September has secured Rep. Thomas Massie (R-Ky.) the votes he needs to force a discharge petition on a vote to release all DOJ files on Epstein. Massie has criticized the Oversight Committee’s release as a sneaky way for the Trump DOJ to curate what comes out and what doesn’t. It’ll be interesting to see what comes of the discharge petition once the government shutdown ends.

#### Jes Staley

Massie, during a House committee hearing on oversight of the FBI in September, dropped the name of another alleged Epstein client and indicated he knew the identities of 19 more. He named Jes Staley, a for-

mer banking executive who worked with Epstein when he was a client of JPMorgan. The Virgin Islands has sued JPMorgan, Staley’s former employer and Epstein’s former bank, and accused Staley himself of funneling Epstein’s money. The lawsuit revealed emails that suggested “that Staley may have been involved in Epstein’s sex-trafficking operation,” according to reports about the suit. Court documents said Epstein shared photos of young women with Staley. The two had also a discussion that appeared to use Disney characters as code.

Staley has never been charged with sexual crimes. However, he was nevertheless “forced out at Barclays in 2021 as the Financial Conduct Authority, the UK-equivalent of the Securities and Exchange Commission, launched an investigation into allegations that Staley misled the agency and the Barclays board about his dealings with Epstein,” according to reports.

#### Massie Still Fighting

In early September, Massie and

Ro Khanna (D-Calif.) held a press conference with eight other alleged Epstein victims. That’s when one of them, Lisa Phillips, said they were going to release their own list. “We know the names,” she said. “Many of us were abused by them. Now, together as survivors, we will confidentially compile the names we all know, who are regularly in the Epstein world. It will be done by survivors, and for survivors.” Afterward, Massie said he would work with the victims to release the names, lest they all be sued into oblivion.

The Royals’ decision to banish Andrew only piles onto the already high stack of evidence suggesting there is much more to Epstein’s operation. It bolsters the raging suspicions that Epstein provided minors for sex to very powerful people. He almost certainly did not traffic only to himself, and almost certainly did traffic to other high-profile figures. It is a stunning display of audacity by the DOJ to continue to pretend it has no credible evidence suggesting otherwise.

### The end of QT and the “no landing” scenario have arrived

The jig is up, and Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell has finally admitted it. What we’ve long telegraphed has arrived right on schedule and the Fed is already warming up the printers. To understand why, we’ll do a recap of the financial plumbing in the Fed-controlled system, which you can of course read in greater detail in our earlier posts. Here’s what you need to know right now.

The Fed has painted itself into a corner because they’ve actually abandoned most of their monetary tools, at least for their traditional purposes. Under Powell, the Fed has chosen to turn the dials mostly to influence the financial plumbing, not inflation or the labor market. In truth, those last two are secondary considerations, despite them being virtually all that Powell and his colleagues discuss—their “dual mandate.”

What Powell & Co. are really laser focused on right now is liquidity and bank reserves, the latter being the money that banks have parked at the Fed. For about a century, the only reason banks kept money parked idle in the Fed vaults was because they had to. Not so today. The Fed abolished the reserve requirement in 2020 and started paying banks interest on reserves (for several years prior, the Fed paid interest on “excess reserves” which was anything above the reserve requirement). Powell & Co. also expanded the reverse repurchase agreement (reverse repo) facility which essentially functioned the same way.

Reverse repos pay interest just like bank reserves, and there’s only a few basis points difference in the rates. In both cases, the Fed is keeping liquidity on the sidelines—ready for action, but out of the fray. Repos and

reverse repos were supposed to be like shock absorbers, temporary ways for the Fed to quickly inject or absorb liquidity, respectively. It’s faster than changing open market operations and it’s not permanent since these are short-term loans, not mere exchanges like the purchase or sale of securities.

The Fed changed the rules of the game after the unprecedented money printing that began in 2020. When reverse repos were exploding, that was the signal for the Fed to call it quits, but they didn’t. The Fed kept printing. Reverse repos at the New York Fed (the main trading desk, though all 12 branches have one) topped out at over \$2.5 trillion, partly due to an end of year spike as liquidity looked for somewhere to go when banks were awash with cash to appease regulators.

When the Fed belatedly stopped buying securities (euphemistically referred to as quantitative easing, or QE) and then started selling assets, that’s quantitative tightening, or QT—the liquidity drain was on. The Fed had finally pulled the plug on the overflowing bathtub and the water level started falling. Much of what happened initially was transferring spilled water back into the tub so that the level didn’t fall



much. As a very loose analogy, think of the reverse repos as towels that had soaked up the overflowing water on the floor and draining the reverse repo facility was like wringing out those towels back into the tub.

Fast forward to today and the reverse repo is completely drained. For several

days, we’ve seen the repo facility be tapped, meaning the Fed is injecting liquidity. Of course, the sums here are so trivial that they’re not even rounding errors for the Fed. Two or three billion dollars a day in a repo market that’s well over \$1 trillion is effectively nothing.

That brings us to what we forecasted a while ago: the Fed has drained all the liquidity it can before things start running too dry. Since Powell & Co. are primarily focused on the financial system’s plumbing, this will force their hand into adding liquidity. A.K.A., printing money.

The first step in this process has already been expressly said by Powell himself during a recent public address, wherein he declared QT would end soon. Of course, that’s just step one. Will this solve the Fed’s underlying problem? No, not at all. It merely buys time, and very little time at that.

The Fed’s pyramid scheme requires bank reserves to grow over time,

essentially maintaining ratios with things like the size of the economy or the level of bank assets. The problem for Powell & Co. is that those things are growing. That means bank reserves have to grow, or things will start to break. QT, rather problematically, has been reducing bank reserves ever since the debt ceiling was lifted earlier this year and the Treasury then had to compete with the Fed for loanable funds. The result was banks deciding to lend to Bessent instead of Powell, and that’s drying up bank reserves, not to a historically low level, but one that’s below the ridiculously high level of “abundant” reserves and is not just “ample” reserves—what some call the DANGER zone.

Just like the Autumn of 2019, the Fed today is starting to lose control, first of interest rates and then something much worse. The latest secured overnight financing rate (SOFR) is at the upper bound of the Fed funds rate target range, and SOFR has recently even exceeded this upper bound a couple of times.

Similar to backwardation, we’ve seen overnight lending become more expensive on secured than unsecured loans via Fed funds—a sign something is amiss at best and terribly wrong at worst. Powell & Co. are on the verge of losing control, but they won’t, of course. They’ll take even more control instead. That starts with ending QT, which will happen at either this week’s meeting or the next.

There’ll be no more runoff of Treasuries and as old ones on the balance sheet mature, the Fed will simply buy new ones to replace them. However, this only stops the destruction of bank reserves—it doesn’t increase them. That’s where the next round of QE comes in. It may take the Fed a few more months, but the system they’ve built requires more bank

### Senior IDF Official Arrested After Leaking Footage Exposing Israeli Torture Of Palestinian POWs

Major-General Yifat Tomer-Yerushalmi's resigns as chief legal officer of the Israeli military after she leaked footage exposing brutal torture of Palestinian detainees at the Sde Teiman camp. The leaked surveillance video, aired by Channel 12, depicted IDF reservists committing violent sexual assault and torture against prisoners, resulting in indictments for several soldiers. Tomer-Yerushalmi's motivation was to counter misinformation and demonstrate the reality of institutionalized abuse, despite fierce opposition from within Israel's ruling

coalition. The revelations led to widespread outrage, but also a severe backlash against Tomer-Yerushalmi and her supporters, with top politicians accusing her of fabricating "blood libels" against the IDF and undermining national security. Far-right ministers, led by Itamar Ben-Gvir, not only called for punishment of whistleblowers but also incited violence, underscoring political turmoil and polarization. Tomer-Yerushalmi was placed on forced leave, subjected to a criminal probe, and ultimately resigned, invoking the deterioration of morality within Israeli leadership. Following her resigna-

tion, she went missing temporarily, prompting a police search before being located, and was subsequently arrested alongside the former chief prosecutor for leaking classified information.

Amid intense political recrimination, protests, and personal threats, the Israeli government maintained its denial of systematic abuse, despite corroborating evidence from UN investigations which also concluded widespread torture and sexual violence against Palestinian detainees. The focus of Israeli authorities shifted to investigating the leak rather than the crimes it exposed. The article argues that the persecution

of those who reveal war crimes, rather than those who commit them, reflects a deep institutionalization of abuse and moral inversion within Israeli military and political circles.

reserves over time, and just maintaining the status quo of the balance sheet's current level will soon push the system below "ample" reserves. That's when we go to "scarce" reserves territory and the Board of Governors run around with their hair on fire.

What if the Fed cuts rates at the same time they stop QT? Surely even more easy monetary policy will help, right? Unfortunately, no. Returning to an earlier point, Powell & Co. have straightjacketed many of their monetary tools into plumbing tools only, so very few dials can be turned without having adverse and counterproductive consequences. Each time they cut rates, it reduces the incentive for banks to keep money parked at the Fed in reserves. This could very quickly exacerbate the problem as banks pull money out of Fed vaults and loan it to the Treasury or the private sector.

Ironically, Powell & Co. might need to step on the gas and brake at the

same time to increase reserves at flank speed: QE (gas) to regrow the balance sheet and push liquidity into the system while hiking rates (brake) to incentivize banks keeping more of that liquidity in reserve. That'll cause reverse repos to zoom back up as the Fed works to maintain an interest rate floor while flooding liquidity into the banks.


Of course, this is a recipe to strangle the real economy while paying tons of interest to the bankers. Sound familiar? That's because we've lived through a version of that for the last several years, with both financial firm profits and asset prices exploding higher, but the average Joe just gets inflation.

Today, it also means the Treasury has to compete vigorously for loanable funds, which is making it more expensive to finance the national debt. Regardless, "Printer is Coming." This isn't a secret and the well-informed in the financial sector know it. That's why they began buying gold when we alerted readers to do so as well, and guess what? They're still buying. Even at well over \$4,000 an ounce. That should tell you something.

Much of the coming QE is already priced into gold because the smart money saw the writing on the wall earlier this year when liquidity was

just getting tight, even before the government could borrow because of the debt ceiling. As soon as that restriction was lifted, the plumbing system got much worse—exactly as expected.

So, how to look at the coming storm? In brief, it's a buy-everything opportunity. That doesn't mean the real value of everything is going to increase, but rather that the price of everything will. As the dollar loses value, it'll take more of those dollars to buy anything and everything. Stonks only go up, as it were.



Things with a monetary premium or financialized assets (like gold, silver, Bitcoin, housing, collectibles, etc.) tend to appreciate in price much more during these episodes. The return of QE is very bullish on a whole lot of stuff, but will of course cause much more inflation, impoverishing everyone and siphoning off the real value of countless people's savings and earnings. It is, as Lenin correctly said, the best way to destroy the capitalist system.

Powell thought he could engineer the mythical "soft landing" scenario—which has never, ever been achieved by the Fed—wherein he would bring down inflation and not create a recession. Powell was wrong, and now he's choosing "no

landing," meaning we stave off a recession in exchange for the inflation. In that sense, we all lose—but you can mitigate the damage in your own life.

Now, if the Fed's plan is so terrible, what's the solution? Get back to basics. The central bank needs to reinstitute the reserve requirement, first and foremost. Stop paying banks not to lend. Second, don't stop but accelerate the balance sheet runoff.

Wait, won't that lead to a catastrophic collapse in the money supply? Not at all. It will be directly countered by banks loaning money that was previously parked at the Fed. Then, let the Fed funds rate float and just set the discount rate (price to borrow directly from the Fed) at a steep penalty to the prior day's Fed funds rate. This same methodology can also be used on both repo desks until they eventually get shut down too.

Is that all pie in the sky, wishful thinking? Probably, but until the Fed finally does the right thing, we'll still be figuring out how to protect ourselves from their mistakes.






### Richmond/Cowichan land title case in B.C.

The Cowichan land title case in British Columbia



represents a landmark decision in Canadian Indigenous law and land rights, confirming Aboriginal title over significant urban lands. The British Columbia Supreme Court ruled in August 2025 that the Quw'utsun Nation, also known as the Cowichan Tribes, holds Aboriginal title to about 5.7 square kilometres of land in Richmond, on the south shore of Lulu Island by the Fraser River. This ruling declared that Crown and municipal fee simple titles granted over this land were "defective and invalid" because they unjustifiably infringed on the Cowichan's Aboriginal title, setting a precedent for how Indigenous land claims intersect with private and Crown land ownership across Canada.

The case arose from a 513-day trial

that spanned over 11 years, making it one of the longest and most complex in Canadian history. The Cowichan Tribes presented extensive oral histories, expert testimonies, and historical records to prove their longstanding connection to the land. The court recognized Aboriginal title extended even to lands that had been granted as fee simple ownership to the Crown, the City of Richmond, and some private owners. It importantly clarified that Aboriginal title exists beyond the provincial Land Title Act system, which typically guarantees the indefeasibility of registered land titles, meaning the Cowichan's Aboriginal title is constitutionally protected despite the legal titles held by others.


The ruling has caused significant public and political debate, especially among affected homeowners in Richmond, who expressed confusion and concern about the security of their property titles. The Cowichan Tribes

emphasized they do not intend to dispossess private homeowners of their land but called for the federal and provincial governments to negotiate in good faith to reconcile the different land interests. The governments and the City of Richmond are appealing the decision and seeking a stay of its implementation to allow more legal clarity and negotiation to unfold, reflecting the case's far-reaching implications for reconciliation efforts and private property rights in British Columbia and beyond.

Beyond the immediate legal impact, this case symbolizes broader issues of Indigenous sovereignty, reconciliation, and recognition of historic land rights, particularly regarding unceded territories in Canada. It highlights the ongoing tensions between private property rights under Canadian law and Indigenous Aboriginal title based

on traditional connection and use. The decision is considered a significant victory for the Cowichan Tribes and a crucial precedent that may influence future Indigenous land claims across the country. However, it also underlines the complexity of balancing legal frameworks, historical justice, and practical coexistence of different land interests.

In sum, the Cowichan land title case is a landmark legal and social milestone that challenges traditional understandings of land ownership in Canada. It acknowledges Indigenous title over urban lands with existing private ownership, instructs governments to negotiate to reconcile these interests fairly, and exemplifies the evolving landscape of reconciliation between Indigenous peoples and the Crown. The case's lasting impact will shape land rights, governance, and reconciliation policies in British Columbia and across Canada for years to come

The story of Alzheimer's disease is not just one of scientific failure but of missed opportunities for inclusive innovation and compassionate care. To truly meet the needs of diverse populations, stakeholders must look beyond narrow, profit-driven models and embrace a broader view of brain health—one that is sensitive to the socioeconomic, cultural, and biological realities of all people living with dementia.

This means prioritizing research that addresses root causes over

symptom management, actively incorporating patient and caregiver voices into care design, and making accessible therapies a central focus of treatment. Lifestyle interventions, nutritional support, and individualized protocols—supported by robust science but adaptable to local contexts—offer hope for restoring dignity, independence, and well-being for millions affected by Alzheimer's and related conditions.

If we are to solve the Alzheimer's crisis, we must shift the conversation from one dominated by commercial interest and outdated dogma to one driven by scientific integrity, inclusivity, and patient empowerment.
