## Gratitude is a Super Power

Neuroscientists find that the Medial prefrontal cortex and the anterior cingulate cortex are involved in the self-perception of one’s life path, positive growth, motivation, and emotional intelligence. \* Perhaps the most direct version of this is found in the Qur’an’s 14:7, “If you are grateful, I will give you more. If you are ungrateful, punishment is severe.”

\* In Hinduism’s Bhagavad Gita, “If one offers with devotion, I will accept with love.” In Bhakti it is taught that gratitude and devotion evoke grace.

\* In Buddhism, gratitude is a foundational practice that cultivates mindfulness and compassion and leads to blessings in your personal life.

\* In Sikhism, daily gratitude is said to lift the spirit and bring about auspicious outcomes.

\* Sufism teaches that gratitude attracts an increase in blessings.

\* Yoga teaches that gratitude is a clear, luminous, state of mind that draws grace and auspicious coincidence towards the practitioner.

\* 33 in the Tao Te Ching says that contentment brings wealth.

\* Hermetic traditions, the Principles of Correspondence and Vibration teach that a grateful inner state has a resonance that attracts more experiences to be grateful for.

Gratitude greatly increases opportunity, protection, guidance, harmony with others, self-sufficiency, and overall peace. This is true whether you choose to believe that it’s just the neuroscience of having better control of emotions, clearer perception, and stronger social bonds, or if you believe that the world we live in resonates in response to the vibrations we generate. 

Unless this corruption is purged, both religion and liberty will fall together. For irreligion breeds moral anarchy, and superstition breeds political slavery. Only moral and religious people can remain free.

Our task, then, is plain. We must be both teachers and reformers, soldiers in the war for the mind and apostles of moral truth. Every degree of light we spread drives back the darkness of oppression and prepares mankind for self-government. Every act of virtue strengthens the walls of freedom and defies the march of tyranny.

### FBI Seeks Interview With “Seditious Six” for “Illegal Order” Video, as Retired Officers Denounce Kelly

The fallout has continued for far-left Democrat Senator Mark Kelly of Arizona, who participated in the seditious video in which he and five colleagues importuned members of the military to disobey orders they deem illegal. Kelly even came under fire for not displaying his decorations properly on his uniform in an X reply to War Secretary Pete Hegseth.

The FBI is looking to interview what are now called the Seditious Six. More retired officers are now denouncing Kelly, who might be recalled to active duty to face a court martial for causing insubordination in the ranks, or worse, mutiny.

#### The Video and Replies

Kelly’s possible recall to active duty began when he, CIA Democrat Senator Elissa Slotkin of Michigan, and four others importuned service members to disobey orders they judged “illegal.” The six claimed that servicemen “must refuse illegal orders” because “no one has to carry out orders that violate the law or our Constitution.” The video invited fury from President Trump, who accused the six of sedition and wrote that it is “punishable by death.” Medal of Honor recipient Dakota Meyer, a former Marine, wrote on Substack that the Seditious Six are confusing rank and file service members.

The War Department then warned that Kelly could be in big trouble. Noting it had received “serious allegations” against Kelly, the department cited 18 U.S. Code 2387 — “activities affecting armed forces generally.” That code applies to anyone who “advises, counsels, urges, or in any manner causes or attempts to cause insubordination, disloyalty, mutiny, or refusal of duty by any member of the military or naval forces of the United States; or

Slotkin, who confessed she didn’t have any evidence that Trump has issued illegal orders, denounced the move despite the video’s obvious implication. “Last night, the FBI’s Counterterrorism Division appeared to open an inquiry into me in response to a video President Trump did not like,” Slotkin wrote on X: “The President directing the FBI to target us is exactly why we

made this video in the first place. He believes in weaponizing the federal government against his perceived enemies and does not believe laws apply to him or his Cabinet. He uses legal harassment as an intimidation tactic to scare people out of speaking up. This isn’t just about a video. This is not the

America I know, and I’m not going to let this next step from the FBI stop me from speaking up for my country and our Constitution.”

For his part, Kelly said he’s a combat veteran and won’t be intimidated. “Donald Trump can try to intimidate me, but it’s not going to work,” he wrote on X over video of the same message: “My job is to defend the Constitution and hold any president accountable.”

#### Other Former Officers Respond

Former high-ranking officers aren’t happy with Kelly’s participation in the seditious video. Buzz Patterson, former Air Force lieutenant colonel and military aide to President Bill Clinton, denounced Kelly in no uncertain terms. Patterson said he is “appalled... They are violating and politically using their positions to undercut the command of President Donald J. Trump and they’re circumventing the chain of command... Prosecutions are warranted and legitimate.” He predicted that because the Seditious Six “violated the military chain of command, people are gonna die.” As did Meyer, Patterson noted that the six are asking

rank-and-file enlisted personnel to risk their careers. Patterson said he is “outraged,” and fears what happens to young soldiers, sailors, airmen, and Marines if they follow the Democrats’ advice.

Retired Air Force Colonel Rob Maness, now a radio talk show host, said Kelly trespassed Article 94 of the Uniformed Code of Military Justice, which is also covered in 10 U.S. Code 894, mutiny or sedition. Because Kelly, “who is their leader, didn’t specify an [illegal] order ... their video’s a call to mass insubordination, the destruction of the authority of the commander-in-chief, and those appointed by him ... They had recently been questioned as to what the unlawful order was and can’t name one,” he said.

Both men agreed with Hegseth, who roasted Kelly for improperly displaying his decorations in an X post. “So ‘Captain’ Kelly, not only did your sedition video intentionally undercut good order & discipline... but you can’t even display your uniform correctly,” he wrote on X: “Your medals are out of order & rows reversed. When/if you are recalled to active duty, it’ll start with a uniform inspection.”

Another observer (rank and service, if any, unknown) explained the defects in the medal display at length:

- Wrong order of precedence
- Uneven, staggered rows
- Good Conduct Medal isolated below the pocket
- Overall sloppy appearance

Navy regulations “demand strict precedence from right to left, even rows, and no strays,” the post avers: “Kelly’s display, while perhaps intentional for a viral photo, is unmistakably incorrect by uniform standards.”



distributes or attempts to distribute any written or printed matter which advises, counsels, or urges insubordination, disloyalty, mutiny, or refusal of duty by any member of the military or naval forces of the United States.”

#### FBI Seeks Interview

Now, the matter has escalated. The FBI has requested interviews with the six, news reports revealed today. A source in the Justice Department told Reuters that the interviews “were to determine ‘if there’s any wrongdoing, and then go from there.’”

## We're Approaching the "Blame the Consumer" Stage of the Boom-Bust Cycle

For those of us who have lived through past recessions, this latest development comes as no surprise: as the US economy worsens, we're now being told that consumers are hurting the economy because they are saving too much money.



Americans aren't spending as much money on smartphones, and that it's "costing the economy." He writes: "If you are holding onto your aging printer or cracked smartphone longer than you had planned, you are not alone..."

The average American now holds onto their smartphone for 29 months ... and that cycle is getting longer. The average was around 22 months in 2016. While squeezing as much life out of your device as possible may save money in the short run, especially amid widespread fears about the strength of the consumer and job market, it might cost the economy in the long run..."

This is a pretty common trope among the regime economists whose job it is—apparently—to incessantly harangue the American consumer into spending every last dime he has on corporate America's trinkets. After all, if the consumer saves "too much" money this will send the US economy into a liquidity trap. At least, that's how the official narrative goes.

Regular readers of mises.org won't be shocked to hear that the alleged liquidity trap isn't real, and it's not at all a problem if consumers save money rather than spend it. After all, real economic progress depends on a sustainable foundation of saving and investment, and not on consumers frittering away their retirements on another round of luxury cars and Caribbean cruises.

Back in 2001 in the days of the dot-com bust, then-vice president Dick Cheney said that Americans who were falling on hard times ought to "support the troops"—remember that worthless propaganda phrase?—by spending more money on retail goods. If you saved your money, then the terrorists won.

As the 2008 recession got underway the story was the same, but with less jingoism. Paul Krugman, for example, promulgated the usual Keynesian gospel with an article titled "When Consumers Capitulate" and explained how saving is a bad thing because "individual virtue can be public vice" and "attempts by consumers to do the right thing by saving more can leave everyone worse off." In other words, saving money will backfire so you're hurting America by spending less. So, just as we might look for daffodils to emerge from the snow as a sign of the coming spring, we look for signs of a worsening economy in the form of patronizing columns telling consumers that they're not spending enough money.

Perhaps the earliest sign of this phenomenon in the current cycle was April's Wall Street Journal article—titled "Your New Lunch Habit Is Hurting the Economy"—lecturing consumers for brown-bagging their lunches. It certainly didn't end there. In a Sunday column for CNBC, Kevin Williams trots out the creaky old Krugmanian "arguments" and

wrings his hands over the fact that Amer-

How exactly is it "costing" the economy? Well, it seems that if you're not spending every last nickel on a new iPhone—remember, they don't make pennies anymore, thanks to inflation—then you are losing milliseconds of lost "productivity." The solution? Go further into debt for a \$900 phone so that you can more quickly stay up to date on AI-created cat videos. The economics "experts" tell us that if you're saving your money instead of buying more "efficient" tech, then you're not an optimal cog in the machine of the corporate tax farm we call "the United States."

Of course, one may ask, how do the "experts" know if I'm better off buying a new phone, or if I'm better off saving that money for other priorities? How do they know if it's more "efficient" for me to spend my money on a phone now, rather than on, say, tuition for my child's education? The answer is they don't have a clue what makes any consumer better off. The usual media-quoted economists only claim to know these things because they have been trained to mindlessly come up with new reasons as to why it's always better for regular people to spend as much money as possible, at all times.

Again, this new call to buy newer smart phones is just the first sign of what is to come, as it becomes increasingly clear that consumers are tapped out. The early signs are there, such as rising delinquency rates for automobiles and credit cards. Hiring is essentially flat, and the unemployment rate is rising, even as immigrants self-deport by the hundreds of thousands. October foreclosures were up, year over year, by 32 percent.

We can expect more articles like this CNBC column moving forward, with "warnings" about how consumers should spend more or else fall prey to the savings-induced evils of "inefficiency" or even outright recession.

Now is a good time to remind ourselves, though, of why these calls for maximum and immediate spending get it wrong. The key to economic growth has never been spending as much money as possible on existing products and services right now. Rather, a vibrant economy can come from saving and investment which will in turn become essential capital that is transformed into productive enterprises in the future.

That is, a better economy in the future requires saving and investment now. There is no need to worry about the consumers saving their money "too much." Bob Murphy explains: "It will be useful to spell out exactly what happens in a market economy when consumers decide to save more of their income. The first thing to realize is that people do not decide to "spend" or not; rather, they decide whether to spend in the present versus in the future. For example, imagine that thousands of couples in a large city one day decide to skip their weekly restaurant outings in order to save up for a summer cruise. At first, it seems

that this would hurt the economy. After all, local restaurants see their sales drop, and so they buy fewer items from their suppliers and lay off some workers. The suppliers and workers in turn have less income to spend, and so sales are hurt elsewhere too.

However, so long as the entrepreneurs involved in the cruise industry anticipate the eventual increase in demand for their services, they will exactly offset the above effects when they hire more workers and other items in preparation for the busy summer months. The new savings (which were previously spent on restaurants) drives down interest rates, perhaps allowing the cruise operators to borrow money and pay for an additional liner. Thus the decision to save more doesn't reduce total income or employment, once everyone adjusts to the new spending patterns. It is really no different from a scenario where thousands of people become health conscious and decide to spend their money on

vegetables rather than fast food."

CNBC would have you believe "the economy" suffers when we don't buy more new phones. In reality, it's just iPhone sellers who suffer. The economy and Apple are not the same thing. In any case, no consumer should ever allow himself to be convinced that he hurts either himself or "the economy" by saving money.



Low Rockwell notes: "This also defies everything we know about family finance. The path to a secure prosperity is delaying consumption. One should spend as little as possible and save as much as possible for the future, and let that money be used in the service of investments that yield a solid rate of return. Those who have chosen a different path now see the folly: they are being burned in the soft housing market, for example.

The lesson is also true for the nation at large, because the logic doesn't

magically change when moving from the family budget to the national stage. Just because something involves "macroeconomics" doesn't mean that we should throw out all good sense. But that is precisely what people have done with regard to the economy, since J.M. Keynes somehow convinced the world that up is down and left is right.

In a recession or a crisis, the right approach for individuals is to save. So too for the national economy. A looming recession will prompt a pullback in consumer spending as a rational response to the perception of economic troubles. This action does not cause the economy to fall into recession any more than more spending can save it from recession. The downturn is a fact that cannot be avoided. We don't blame umbrellas for floods, and, in the same way, we shouldn't blame tightfisted consumers for recessions."

So, there is no liquidity trap and saving doesn't cause recessions and we can safely ignore all the future media articles about how saving money is bad news for the economy.

### Trump Turns on MTG as MAGA Implosion Continues

In another sign that the MAGA coalition is imploding, President Donald Trump pulled back his endorsement of Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene, the Republican firebrand from Georgia who, until recently, was one of his most devoted supporters. Moreover, the president said he would endorse a primary challenger. Greene, who was inspired to first run for Congress by Trump, has become increasingly critical of him.

“Over the past few weeks, despite my creating Record Achievements for our Country ... all I see ‘Wacky’ Marjorie do is COMPLAIN, COMPLAIN, COMPLAIN!” Trump said Friday in a Truth Social post. “I understand that wonderful, Conservative people are thinking about ‘primarying’ Marjorie in her District of Georgia, that they too are fed up with her and her antics and, if the right per-

son runs, they will have my Complete and Unyielding Support.”

The next day, he went after Greene again: “Lightweight Congresswoman Marjorie Taylor Brown (Green grass turns Brown when it begins to ROT!), betrayed the entire Republican Party when she turned Left, performed poorly on the pathetic View, and became the RINO that we all know she always was. Just another Fake politician, no different than Rand Paul Jr. (Thomas Massie), who got caught being a full-fledged Republican In Name Only (RINO)! MAKE AMERICA GREAT AGAIN!!!” Trump said in his signature low-brow fashion.

#### What Happened?

Trump told reporters while on Air Force One that Greene had changed, that something had happened to her, but it’s no mystery what has happened. Like many others, Greene has become disillusioned with Trump’s failure to

deliver on some of his most important America First promises. She has made several public comments indicating that she’s frustrated with his excessive focus on foreign matters and his refusal to halt foreign aid to all countries — while average Americans continue to struggle with the high cost of everyday items. Greene voiced these concerns in her conversation with the leftist women on the talk show *The View*. “People are so tired of their hard-earned tax dollars being sent overseas to foreign wars, and foreign aid, and foreign causes — while life in America just becomes more and more unaffordable. We want this money invested at home for our infrastructure, for our programs, for our people,” she said.

#### Part of a Pattern

Trump’s recent split with Greene is part of a pattern. He has also turned on Representative Thomas Massie (R-Ky.), who has also opposed the president’s foreign policy and fiscal recklessness. Trump has supported the idea of primarying Senator Rand Paul (R-Ky.) — who has voted against Trump-backed budget bills and made the media rounds criticizing his interventionist foreign policy.

Greene, Massie, and Paul are among the few federal legislators with proven constitutional voting records. The New American’s Freedom Index [a rating of how consistently a member of Congress votes in line with the U.S. Constitution] gives Greene a 97% cumulative score, Massie a 99% score, and Paul a score of 96%.

To make matters worse, Trump not only attacks the principled legislators, but he backs the worst of them. He has endorsed one of the most Constitution-averse, war-loving neocons in all of Congress. Senator Lindsey Graham (R-S.C.) represents everything that’s wrong with the Republican Party. He loves big spending, big government, and military adventur-

ism. He’s a huge fan of spending piles of cash on overseas wars and foreign aid. He is the epitome of a Uniparty swamp creature, and his 57% cumulative Freedom Index score reflects it. Nevertheless, earlier this year, Trump announced, “Senator Lindsey Graham has my Complete and Total Endorsement for Re-Election — HE WILL NOT LET YOU DOWN. Everyone in South Carolina should help Lindsey have a BIG WIN next year!”

#### The Epstein Files

In addition to opposition to foreign wars and deficit spending, Greene, Massie, and Paul have been pushing for transparency about Jeffrey Epstein, another point of frustration for Trump. When he campaigned last year, Trump said he would support releasing the Epstein files, albeit with some hesitation. But for months now, he has been trying to put the kibosh on that very transparency, igniting a firestorm of backlash among his base and supporters in the media. As a result, suspicion has grown among conservatives that Trump may indeed have something to hide. The emails released last week did little to put those suspicions to rest.

Massie has been working with Democrat Ro Khanna of California on a discharge petition to bypass House leadership and force a vote on a resolution that would release Justice Department files on Epstein. The special election victory of Adelita Grijalva (D-Ariz.) gave Massie the 218 votes he needed to push the vote onto the House floor. With Massie included, only four Republicans signed the petition. Last week, Trump unsuccessfully pressured at least one of those legislators, Representative Lauren Boebert (R-Colo.), to withdraw her signature, according to reports.



By Sunday, Massie was telling the media that he expected “a hundred or more” House Republicans to vote for the resolution. Sensing the inevitable, by Sunday evening, Trump caved and issued a surprising reversal. “House Republicans should vote to release the Epstein files, because we have nothing to hide, and it’s time to move on from this Democrat Hoax perpetrated by Radical Left Lunatics in order to deflect from the Great Success of the Republican Party,” he said in a Truth Social Post. “I DON’T CARE! All I do care about is that Republicans get BACK ON POINT ...”

On Monday, Massie thanked the president for encouraging Republicans to vote yes on the resolution. He told reporters, “He got tired of me winning,” a soft elbow in the side of the president, who just days earlier said, in a bizarrely juvenile social media post, that Massie’s wife “will soon find out that she’s stuck with a LOSER!” House Republicans will vote on releasing the DOJ’s Epstein files tomorrow.

### MAGA Implosion

Despite Trump’s recent reversal on the Epstein files, the MAGA camp is imploding. While he has



done some things well — he’s largely delivered on

border security and energy — Trump has made a series of bad decisions. And the people are frustrated. A recent theory is that behind Trump’s downfall is his chief of staff, Susie Wiles, whose long neocon and lobbying background was suspect from the beginning. We profiled Wiles in a February print issue. “Wiles will also have a say in who gains access to the president. That type of gatekeeping power has some in MAGA Land

worried, given Wiles’ Establishment pedigree,” we noted.

Raheem Kassam, editor-in-chief of The National Pulse, recently tied Wiles to the early November poll from CNN showing Trump’s disapproval rating rising to an all-time high of 63 percent. Kassam wrote in a social media post, “There has been more focus on the international than the domestic economy so far this year,” adding, “With Susie Wiles vetoing anything remotely MAGA, the White House agenda has trended back to a more corporate-friendly GOP median, which is leading to Dems leading on the generic ballot question for the first time since 2022.”

Moreover, Wiles is also getting credit for sabotaging the MAHA (Make America Healthy Again) movement. The Redacted podcast hosted whistleblowers Dr. Steven Hatfill and Gray Delany, who said this very thing.

Health and Human Services Secretary Robert F. Kennedy, Jr., however, defended Wiles as recently as Friday. He said in an X post, “The MAHA movement has no better friend in Washington than Susie Wiles, who has supported every effort to end the chronic disease epidemic and restore health freedom to every American.”

### America First

Trump is not even one year into

this term and the coalition he has led for 10 years is in danger of completely collapsing. His neocon foreign policy, deficit spending, and attempt to make the Epstein saga go away without further transparency has alienated his base.

Sensing that he’s losing his influence, he recently declared himself to be the movement. Newsweek reported: “Don’t forget: MAGA was my idea. MAGA was nobody else’s idea,” he said on The Ingraham Angle. “I know what MAGA wants better than anyone else, and MAGA wants to see our country thrive.”

Trump is wrong. MAGA was not his idea. The idea of a leadership class that prioritizes its citizens and national sovereignty is a fundamental element of Americanism that has always existed to some degree. From Barry Goldwater to the Tea Party to the Ron Paul Revolution, Americans have been yearning for leaders who prioritize secure borders, fiscal responsibility, and a noninterventionist foreign policy.

What Trump has been doing for the last 10 years is tap into a voter base that was already there, a cohort that just needed a point man. Trump didn’t convince people that putting America first was a good idea. He just convinced them that he would do it. And he convinced them that, because he was already rich, he couldn’t be corrupted. Now people are no longer sure any of that is true.

The silver lining here is that this highlights the problem with putting too much faith in personalities. The American Republic our Founders gave us was intentionally designed to distribute power among three branches of government. And the executive was never meant to be the most powerful branch.

It’s long past time to restore to the legislative branch the powers allocated by the U.S. Constitution. We’ve created a tool to do just that, the Freedom Index - A Congressional Scorecard Based on the U.S. Constitution <https://thenewamerican.com/freedom-index/>.

### An Ex-Muslim's Warning to America

It was in 2015 that Muslim refugee Dr. Mudar Zahran warned of the “soft Islamic conquest of the West.” Zahran was referring to the wave of migration affecting Europe, which ultimately saw millions more Muslims enter the Continent. Now, a decade later, an ex-Muslim sounds the same alarm here in America. In fact, she says, operational in the U.S. is a decades-old, clearly stated plan for civilizational jihad. Only, like sheep to the slaughter, most Americans are unaware of it.

Writing at The Christian Post, Hedieh Mirahmadi opens her article talking about a recent viral Dearborn City Council video. In it, a journalist named Cam Higby told the Councilmen that he was pepper-sprayed and robbed, and had equipment destroyed, at a Dearborn “Americans Against Islamification” rally on November 18. The police, however, would do nothing. “I feel like a dhimmi, a second-class citizen,” Higby told the politicians, and this “is what Christians are in the majority of Muslim countries.” He made the attendees uncomfortable, and this was for a very simple reason, states Mirahmadi. He spoke the Truth, realities people would rather ignore.

#### Not Your Grandfather's American Politics

Mirahmadi warns that we're witnessing a historic sea change. The last election cycle “cemented” the ascendancy of Islamists in politics, she says. Two-hundred-eighty Muslims now occupy offices across all U.S. governmental levels, with six being mayors, including Abdullah Hammoud of Dearborn. Why, neighboring Hamtramck, Michigan, recently became the first American city with an entirely Muslim gov-

ernment.

Mirahmadi comments on this transformation: “Elections can produce officials of any background, yet the scale of this rise is not accidental. It mirrors exactly what the Muslim Brotherhood promised in their internal documents 30 years ago, revealed during the Holy Land Foundation terror financing trial. They called it a civilizational jihad. Their words, not mine. Their plan involved softening America through cultural influence, political infiltration, and demographic expansion. The strategy is unfolding exactly as documented, and still, many people refuse to acknowledge it.

The modern West seems to have collectively forgotten the lessons of history. After the collapse of the Ottoman Empire following World War I, Islamic thought leaders announced a shift in the global struggle. Military conquest had failed. The new plan was to expand through demographics, exploit Western religious freedom, and pursue political power from within. They laid this out openly at conferences and published writings. The ideology of expansion never changed. Only the strategy adapted to modern realities. It is astonishing to watch people claim that these observable outcomes are unrelated to the very strategy that was clearly articulated by the ideologues who crafted it.

This once again echoes what Zahran, a self-professed practicing Muslim, warned of regarding the migrations into Europe. “I have to be honest,” he said in a 2015 interview. “You read Arab magazines and Arab newspapers, and they are talking about, ‘Good job! Now we're going to conquer Europe.’ So it's not even a secret.”

#### Revealing More “Secrets”

Mirahmadi, who was a devout, practicing Muslim for more than 20 years, made some other usually buried points:

\* Islam has ever and always been a global, expansionist, mil-

itary-backed ideology.

\* “Islam” means submission; the system is designed to bring civilizations under Islamic norms.

\* Today's “political Islamism” has different means but the same goals as always — remaking societies based on Islamic law.

\* Sharia law explicitly deems women second-class, criminalizes blasphemy, crushes religious freedom, enforces Islamic supremacy, and mandates death for apostasy. It is fundamentally incompatible with Western civilization.

\* Mirahmadi points out that she'd be executed for converting to Christianity (which she did) in several Muslim countries today.

\* Christian ethics' decline has created a moral and spiritual void that aggressive ideologies (Islamism, Marxism, occultism) are filling, especially among relativism-imbued young people.

\* Believers must reclaim public-square confidence, defend the Christian sense of virtue, and recognize our battle's spiritual nature.

Regarding Mirahmadi's fourth bullet point, note that a 2015 poll of Muslims in the U.S. found that 51% believe they should be allowed to govern themselves with Sharia and not American civil law. The 2015 “(Muslim) man on the street” interviews below illustrate this — and more — shockingly.

Eyebrows apparently raised, one YouTube commenter addressed the above and perhaps spoke for many. “What's striking about this video is that the people being interviewed are civil, decent and friendly,” he said. “Probably hardworking, too. What they say, however, is unjust and dangerous to the extreme... What people believe really does matter.”

#### Discernment

This brings us to why we've



slouched into balkanization to begin with. That is, too many of our basic assumptions are wrong. First, in the grip of immigrationism, we've neglected to view prospective newcomers qualitatively and as completely human. For example, it's common to ask, “What skills do the immigrants have? What work roles can they fill?”

Such inquiry would suffice were immigrants merely entities that perform an economic function — namely, robots. They are instead, however, sentient beings; they have intellect and free will. They come to our shores with religions, ideologies, philosophical foundations, a sense of virtue, cultures, and emotional attachments. Thus must we ask if we're non-suicidal: Are a given immigrant group's beliefs compatible with Americanism? Are the people assimilable? Do we have a bona fide national interest in admitting these immigrants?

For with demography being destiny, large numbers of newcomers will change your civilization. Oh, this change may be a good thing or a bad thing, but for sure it's this: a real thing. Only the foolish would admit immigrants before figuring out which real thing it is.

#### “If Wishes Were Horses...”

Then there's the mistake of religious relativism (which corresponds to relativism generally). This is the idea that “all faiths are morally equal.” It's comforting to many because, it's assumed, we needn't fight over religion if we just fancy them all qualitatively identical. Imagine, though, tackling ideological divisions this way. We could simply

### Is Trump's Third World Immigration Ban a Precursor to the Insurrection Act?

Over the Thanksgiving holiday, U.S. President Donald Trump announced sweeping plans to tighten immigration rules, including a suspension on migration from "Third World Countries" and cancellation of all federal benefits and subsidies to "noncitizens" in the country.

The decision comes after a terror attack (the shooting of two National Guardsmen) involving an Afghan migrant, Rahmanullah Lakanwal, admitted to the US under a program for Afghan refugees launched by Joe Biden in 2021 (Operation Allies Welcome). However, the Trump Admin approved the man's asylum application in 2025 based on his aid to CIA operations in Afghanistan over a ten year period.

The smart move would have been to err on the side of caution, and this is a lesson Trump is apparently taking to heart. In a pair of Truth Social posts late Thursday night, Trump said he would "permanently pause migration from all Third World Countries to allow the U.S. system to fully recover." The president said he would also terminate "millions" of admissions under his predecessor Joe Biden and remove "anyone who is not a net asset to the United States, or is incapable of loving our country."

Trump added he plans to end all federal benefits and subsidies for noncitizens, "denaturalize migrants

who undermine domestic tranquility," and deport any foreign national he described as a "public charge, security risk, or non-compatible with Western Civilization." Critics of Trump argue that he has limited power to implement these changes on a large scale.

Democrats are confident that their activist judges will be able to obstruct Trump's efforts and many Islamic immigrant communities have laughed off threats of deportations under the premise that they are protected by visa extensions, temporary protection status and naturalization status. US House Representative Ilhan Omar claims Trump "doesn't understand the laws" on TPS, for example, and argues that the vast majority of Somali migrants are safe from deportation.

Third world migrant colonies in the US might not be as safe as they think they are. Trump's focus has been on Somali enclaves in places like Minneapolis, MN, where over 25% of all Somalis in the US have congregated, but the problem of migrant colonies is far-reaching.

The surge of Haitian migrants in Springfield, OH took center stage during the presidential debates in 2024 and this tapped into a national conversation about limitations on lack of assimilation by third world asylum seekers. Muslim enclaves in places like Dearborn, MI are another hot topic, with Islamic fundamentalists now essentially running the city and many residents calling for Sharia Law.


Trump already has the ability to cancel TPS extensions, cancel extensions on visas, and expand the ban on immigrant and visa applications from any countries he chooses (19 nations are already on the ban list). However, under the Insurrection Act Trump can deploy the National Guard for direct deportations, rather than simply acting as a barrier between ICE agents and protesters. This would expedite deportations far beyond what is currently possible.

Of course, there will be accusations of constitutional violations, from both Democrats and Republicans. That said, many of these people may not realize how substantial the public support for deportations is. According to surveys, 66% of Americans agree with Trump's de-

The recent attack in Washington DC combined with mass interference from NGO funded activists and Democrat leaders calling for the military to "resist" Trump's "illegal orders" (even though no illegal orders have been issued) is blazing a clear path to one conclusion: The Insurrection Act.

Unfortunately, fault lines don't disappear because you paint them over with the same brush and color. You just don't see them — until the whole illusory edifice collapses underneath you. As with different ideologies, different religions

espouse different values. They thus couldn't all be morally equal unless all values were and, again, that's the bush-league philosophical mistake of relativism. When lukewarm relativists invite passionate absolutists into their midst, they can get a pain-

portation policies, even if a migrant has not committed a crime after entry into the country.

Furthermore, around 40% of Americans back the use of the military for deportations. That's not a majority, but it's a massive portion of the population. If Trump were to implement the Insurrection Act it is likely that he would receive a groundswell of popular support.

In other words, lack of integration among third world asylum seekers is self sabotage. They have become comfortable with the idea that US laws prevent any real intervention against the process of cultural invasion, but this can change rather quickly. For naturalized citizens there are roadblocks in place, but for all other migrants, the breaking point just arrived.

### “Wiping Gaza Off the Map”: Big Money Agenda. Confiscating Palestine’s Maritime Natural Gas Reserves

A summary of Michel Chossudovsky interview with Caroline Mailloux, Lux Media. Watch the full interview at TFPnews.com.

Chossudovsky explains that Israel’s push to dominate Eastern Mediterranean energy is inseparable from the wars, blockades, and diplomatic maneuvers that have defined the fate of Gaza and the wider Levant over the past two decades. At the heart of this struggle are vast offshore gas discoveries—some legally belonging to Palestine—that have been progres-

sively drawn into Israeli control through military campaigns, secret negotiations, and the systematic exclusion of Palestinians from their own natural resources.

#### Gas fields in the Levant

Major gas discoveries such as the Tamar and Leviathan fields, found in 2009 and 2010, turned the Levant Basin into a strategic energy prize, with estimates of around 122 trillion cubic feet of recoverable gas and significant oil potential. While commonly branded as “off the coast of Israel,” parts of these reserves lie in disputed or over-

lapping maritime zones involving Gaza, Lebanon, and Syria, making them a flashpoint for regional tension.

Gaza’s own offshore field, discovered around 2000 by British Gas (BG Group), is estimated at more than 1 trillion cubic feet and legally belongs to Palestine under agreements signed with the Palestinian Authority. Yet Israel’s occupation and control of access to the sea have prevented Palestinians from exploiting these resources, while parallel exploration and export plans have advanced under Israeli and foreign corporate control.

#### Confiscating Gaza’s gas

Chossudovsky and Arbutnot argue that Israeli military operations in Gaza—particularly Operation Cast Lead (2008–09) and the 2023–24 offensive—must be read not only as security or political campaigns but as wars of conquest tied to Gaza’s maritime gas reserves. Negotiations over Gaza Marine repeatedly bypassed the Hamas government and sidelined Palestinian sovereignty, with proposals to pipe Palestinian gas directly to Israeli ports like Ashkelon under Israeli pricing and security terms.

Secret Egypt–Israel talks in 2021–22 reportedly paved the way for joint gas extraction off Gaza, again marginalizing Palestinian authorities while setting a timeline to begin production around 2024 in the name of “Israeli security.” UNCTAD has warned that continued denial of Palestinian control over their oil and gas fields has already cost them billions of dollars in lost revenue and entrenched dependence under occupation.

#### Population removal and energy control

An Israeli Intelligence Ministry memorandum dated October 13, 2023, reportedly examined options for Gaza’s future and favored the mass transfer of its 2.2 million residents to Egypt’s Sinai, aligning



demographic engineering with long-term territorial and resource aims. In this framing, the destruction of Gaza’s infrastructure and the displacement of its people clear the way for de facto Israeli control over the coastline and its energy assets.

The article links this to a broader energy corridor: Israeli offshore platforms, ports like Ashkelon and Haifa, and a proposed connection to Turkey’s Ceyhan terminal, which already receives Caspian oil via the Baku–Tbilisi–Ceyhan pipeline. Integrating Gaza’s gas into this network would cement Israel’s role as a regional energy hub while permanently excluding Palestinians from their most valuable natural endowment.

#### A new “Great Game” in the East Mediterranean

Beyond Gaza, the Levant Basin has drawn in Russia, multinational energy companies, and rival claims by Lebanon and Syria, turning offshore licensing rounds and maritime boundary disputes into a new “Great Game.” Syria’s offshore exploration deal with Russia, Lebanon’s UN filings against Israel’s maritime map, and Turkey–Israel pipeline scenarios all show how energy routes are being redrawn alongside alliances and conflicts.

In this context, Chossudovsky and Arbutnot contend that the language of “security” and “counter-terrorism” masks a deeper logic of resource capture, where borders, blockades, and bombardments are tools to reallocate who owns and profits from the gas under the Mediterranean. The struggle over Palestine’s offshore reserves thus becomes not a side issue, but a central—and often hidden—driver of violence and diplomacy in the region.

### Report: Israel Seeks a 20-Year U.S. Security Pact Pitched as “America First”

Israel has begun negotiations with the United States on an expanded security pact at a moment when political pressure around the relationship between the two countries is rising in Washington. Axios, breaking the story on Thursday, reports “growing frustrations with Israel, including within Trump’s MAGA base,” and says Israeli officials now view this political shift as a factor that makes early action necessary.

According to the outlet, which cites American and Israeli officials, “Israel is seeking a new 20-year security agreement with the U.S. — doubling the usual term and adding “America First” provisions to win the Trump administration’s support.” No previous framework has attempted a commitment of this length. All earlier agreements were set for 10 years.

The timing reflects a straightforward calculation. The current Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) expires in 2028. It totals \$38 billion between 2019 and 2028, or \$3.8 billion per year. However, between October 7, 2023, and September of 2025, the United States has provided considerably more military aid to Israel, totaling at least \$21.7 billion. In addition to that, the United States spent between \$9.65 billion and \$12.07 billion on wars in Yemen, Iran, and other military operations in the region in support of Israel. That brought the total of our support up to \$33.77 billion over the said period.

Axios reports that Israeli officials want the next agreement completed

within the coming year to avoid negotiating in a more unstable political environment. They are seeking the new pact to extend to 2048, Israel’s centennial year.

#### U.S.-Israel Alliance

The proposed pact builds on a long record of expanding U.S.–Israel security arrangements. As Axios notes: “There have been three 10-year framework agreements for long-term security assistance to Israel, in 1998 (\$21.3 billion), 2008 (\$32 billion) and 2016 (\$38 billion).” “Emergency packages,” including the substantial aid approved during the 2024 Gaza campaign, came on top of these baselines. Each cycle raised both expectations and commitments. None reversed the trend.

The underlying logic is laid out in “U.S. Security Assistance to Israel” briefing materials published by the American Israel Public Affairs Committee (AIPAC). The document states: “The United States has long defined Israel’s survival and security as important to its own national interests. Israel helps the United States meet its growing security challenges through close cooperation and a range of innovative technologies.” It explains that annual assistance helps “the Middle East’s only democracy defend itself — by itself — against mounting security threats.”

AIPAC calls this assistance “the most tangible manifestation of American support for the Jewish state,” noting that it primarily consists of funding “for Israel to purchase the arms needed to defend itself from its adversaries.” These

funds take the form of taxpayer-financed grants — officially known as Foreign Military Financing funds (FMF) — that must be spent on U.S.-made weapons. That means much of the money flows directly into the American defense industry.

A core element of this structure is the U.S. commitment to Israel’s Qualitative Military Edge (QME). It is defined as “the ability to counter and defeat any credible conventional military threat while sustaining minimal damages and casualties.” Congress codified this obligation in 2008.

In 1998, the two governments signed their first 10-year memorandum to phase out older aid formats and consolidate security assistance under a predictable framework. Every subsequent agreement followed the same logic: Israel received long-term support, and the United States maintained a stable regional partner while its own defense sector absorbed the bulk of the spending.

#### “America First” Pitch

Israeli officials hope to expand the next package. Axios reports: “Israeli officials hope the next package will include even more in annual assistance, but are concerned the negotiations will be more difficult after the Trump administration’s broad cuts to foreign aid.” Securing such a deal will require political maneuvering. As Axios notes: “The negotiations are both technically and politically complicated, given MAGA’s opposition to foreign aid and bipartisan concerns over Israel’s conduct in Gaza.”

Even Donald Trump acknowledged the scale of destruction in Gaza. Upon taking office, he remarked that the enclave looked like a “demolition site.” This environment shapes how Israeli planners frame their proposal.

Axios describes the new strategy as making it look beneficial for the U.S. military as well as Israel. Besides “extending the agreement from 10 to 20 years ... the Israelis proposed ... to use some of the money for joint U.S.-Israeli research and development, rather than direct military



aid. That could be in the fields of defense tech, defense-related AI, and the Golden Dome missile defense project.”

The report explains the political rationale: “That format is designed to appeal to the Trump administration’s “America First” instincts, because it could benefit the U.S. military rather than just being sent to Israel.”

One Israeli official summed up the shift: “This is out-of-the-box thinking. We want to change the way we handled past agreements and put more emphasis on U.S.-Israel cooperation. Americans like this idea.”

While the “Americans” inside the military-industrial complex — and the politicians aligned with them — may welcome this arrangement, everyday Americans have far less reason to do so.

Will Americans Like This Idea? Indeed, while pitched as mutually beneficial, cooperation in defense tech, AI, and the Golden Dome raises practical concerns. First of all, such collaboration does not require a binding 20-year taxpayer-funded agreement. Secondly, the technologies involved deserve far more scrutiny.

Recent reporting underscores why. Israel’s military campaigns often serve as testing grounds for next-generation war-fighting systems. For instance, media investigations described how AI-powered tools such as the Lavender system generated large numbers of targeting recommendations with minimal human review — a model far removed from traditional battlefield standards.

Some of this technology is already appearing in U.S. civilian contexts. The Grayzone reported last week that the same Skydio drones

There's an argument running through the commentariat that goes something like this: AI (artificial intelligence) has already rendered some jobs obsolete and will continue this trend until the human race is unemployed. Even now it surpasses the ability of most people to write an effective opinion essay because it can create logic-driven, elegant compositions in seconds. Since government schools turn out illiterates, people will depend on AI commentaries for intellectual expression. Combined with research functions that are allegedly dependent on flawed databases, leading users to accept falsehoods in areas such as medicine, government, and economic theory, it renders them easy prey for a program of complete statism, such as socialism.

Why socialism? Because socialists promise to care for the downtrodden, which will be every person left alive when AI achieves full robustness. AI in the hands of a socialist government will feed and house them, and will, of course, see that it's done equitably. This leaves libertarians and conservatives with the urgent need to stop AI in its tracks now, while they still can.

The idea of AI overtaking humanity has a distinguished pedigree. The website PauseAI presents quotes from leaders in their fields about the dangers of runaway AI: Physicist and cosmologist Stephen Hawking had warned that, "The development of full artificial intelligence could spell the end of the human race... It would take off on its own, and re-design itself at an ever increasing rate."

Elon Musk (who is developing his own AI called Grokipedia) said, "AI is a rare case where I think we need to be proactive in regulation rather than be reactive. I think that [digital super intelligence] is the single biggest existential crisis that we face and the most pressing one." Microsoft co-founder Bill Gates thinks "Superintelligent AIs are in our future.... There's the possibility that AIs will run out of control."

## Does AI lead to Socialism?

The founder of computer science and artificial intelligence Alan Turing predicted: "It seems



probable that once the machine thinking method had started, it would not take long to outstrip our feeble powers... They would be able to converse with each other to sharpen their wits. At some stage therefore, we should expect the machines to take control."

Anthropic CEO Dario Amodei has said: "There's a long tail of things of varying degrees of badness that could happen. I think at the extreme end is the Nick Bostrom style of fear that an AGI (Artificial General Intelligence) could destroy humanity. I can't see any reason in principle why that couldn't happen."

The foregoing experts have IQs far beyond ordinary. They are human, subject to error. Inventions that shake up the world have always been feared.

According to Plato, the invention of writing "will implant forgetfulness in [men's] souls. They will cease to exercise memory because they rely on that which is written, calling things to remembrance no longer from within themselves, but by means of external marks." As it happened,

writing by hand can improve memory and learning, especially for children. And, in early America, Thomas Paine

showed incredible recall as he hand-wrote detailed critiques while relying solely on his memory.

Calculators have been said to be another tool for the lazy. In fact, they were found to have "allowed learners to focus on problem-solving rather than mechanical calculations" while fostering confidence in their learning abilities.

While it is in some sense true that the internet has shortened attention spans, there is ample evidence to contradict the claim, such as Substack essays, multi-hour podcasts, and eBooks. If people are engaged in tasks meaningful to them, while working in a supportive environment that keeps dopamine distractions to a minimum they are fully capable of multi-hour focus.

People are not, therefore, inert automatons under control of subversive forces. As Bastiat wrote about in *The Law*, in which he defined socialism as the improper use of force: "When law and force keep a person within the bounds of justice, they impose nothing but a mere negation. They oblige him only to abstain from

harming others. . . . But when the law, by means of its necessary agent, force, imposes upon men a regulation of labor, a method or a subject of education, a religious faith or creed—then the law is no longer negative; it acts positively upon people. It substitutes the will of the legislator for their own wills; the initiative of the legislator for their own initiatives."

There is nothing in AI or AGI that requires the imposition of force, but socialism and its variants do. Socialism as an economic and sociological theory was thoroughly debunked by Ludwig von Mises in 1920 and again in 1922. As Mises argued in his 1920 essay, socialism suffers from the fatal absence of market pricing in producer goods. Even the best-selling socialist author Robert Heilbroner admitted in 1990, "It turns out, of course, that Mises was right. The Soviet system has long been dogged by a method of pricing that produced grotesque misallocations of effort."

The only purpose of an economy is to create goods and services that satisfy human wants, not to create jobs. If AI eliminates jobs in the sense we now understand it, other opportunities will emerge for value creation as they have before when new technologies upset the status quo. Human wants are unlimited, and theory and history have shown that a market free from state intervention is the best way to satisfy them.

A recent poll shows more college students favor socialism than capitalism. This is hardly surprising given the socialist orientation of universities and their misrepresentation of capitalism. As Mises wrote in *Socialism*, "The terms 'Capitalism' and 'Capitalistic Production' are political catchwords. They were invented by socialists, not to extend knowledge, but to carp, to criticize, to condemn." The economic system that has sent students—graduating with four-year degrees, saddled with mountains of debt, and few marketable skills—is the Federal Reserve, income tax, warmongering, interventionist big government monstrosity. This is a gross perversion of capitalism.

### Bovaer: Anti-Methane Supplement Accused of Causing

### Illness and Death in Bovines

The vigilant efforts of a handful of Denmark's farmers have ignited a firestorm of controversy over a dangerous supplement, resulting in a major win for consumers throughout the world.

When the EU began mandating cattle farmers, including milk producers, to feed a pharmaceutical to their stock, few refused. Threatened with heavy fines and criminal prosecution,

farmers 'cowed' to the pressure and began using the new protocol in their herds. The driving force behind this 'science' is the insistence that it will offer protection against climate change by reducing (by 30%) the methane released by bovine flatulence and burping.

As absurd as this entire issue might appear on its face, the fallout has been anything but laughable. Billed as a feed additive 'authorized for sale and commercial use' in approximately 70 countries across the European Union, the Americas and Asia, it was reportedly tested and approved by regulatory agencies throughout the world.

The fallout from using the product in bovines was shockingly swift and devastating for the cattlemen.

They reported cows reacting by refusing to eat, some falling over and being unable to stand again. Many died. Farmers have sought out online venues to tell their stories and show the results of the additive, most of them appearing on platforms such as Bitchute and Rumble. Footage of sick and dying cattle is being narrated by owners insisting that they're using the protocol strictly in accordance with the directions provided and following the accompanying schedules to a tee.

Most of them insist the additive is the only change they've made to the protocols that have provided them with decades of maintaining healthy and strong bovines. Still, Bovaer is being pushed throughout the world. Propo-

product and offering various solutions to determine which products are likely to have been contaminated with this product line. Detractors have accused the proponents of the product of intentionally

withholding information whilst pushing an agenda intended to dissuade the public from eating meat and other products from farmed animals.

One of Denmark's most outspoken critics is Kent Nielsen, a dairy farmer who has pointed out that although Bovaer has been introduced with an 80 day per year mandatory drugging schedule, the

plan is to force feed the product 365 days per year ultimately replacing free range living with permanent confinement.

In Denmark, there was no fallout from the contractual agreements as reportedly exists within other EU sites. For this reason, farmers in Denmark were the only ones that dared raise their voices in opposition to the forced protocol.

It was they (The People) that forced the issue into the public eye and ultimately brought about the boycotts. The resulting pressure mounted quickly: remove it from store shelves before the stores or lose their client base. Those pushing it chose to end the mandates in an effort to provide redress of their grievances.

nents insist that it is safe and effective, and the stated goal (a mere 30% reduction in methane gases emitted by bovines) is proven and whatever issues farmers are seeing is the fault of those incorrectly administering the 'supplement'.

Reports of drastic reductions in milk production, diarrhea, fever, lethargy, weakness, paralysis and death have plagued the program since its rollout in October despite the 'safe and effective' moniker attached to it. Critics charge that it would've been nearly impossible for such quick and horrific side effects to have gone unnoticed during the testing phases government strategists insist took place. Further, some farmers have reported that cattle in which the product was withdrawn before critical illness occurred have subsequently recovered.

The battle lines over Bovaer continue to be drawn. Musk's X.com platform is being utilized as a viable means of discovering which milk products and what beef producers are currently Bovaer free. At least one X user is dedicated to boycotting all things Bovaer and another, @BovaerScout, is a resource for locating restaurants that will not be serving products from animals exposed to Bovaer.

YouTube, too, has seen the trend. Consumer reporters are weighing in on what transpired with the Bovaer

In essence, It created the 'perfect storm' for consumers to be notified and react in a timely manner. Still, it was primarily more by luck than actual planning — and it is unlikely to happen that way again because these same 'loopholes' will undoubtedly be closed in the future.

Many saw and complained that the claims of 'safe and effective' are too often utilized in situations where there has been no real effort to test effectively. The allegations against Bovaer are no exception. The demands for evidence of such testing have been made — but with no real results to date.

### Warning: CRISPR, Capital, and the Slow Erosion of Human Inheritance

If tech billionaires get their way, we may soon live in a future where children are not simply conceived and born, but are instead manipulated genetically before their first breath. What does this mean? Inherited illness is not merely treated before birth, but is edited out altogether. Think stronger bones, sharper minds, and fewer anxieties. Sounds straight out of a dystopian nightmare, but it is not. For *Preventive*, a San Francisco startup backed by OpenAI's Sam Altman and his husband Oliver Mulherin, and Coinbase CEO Brian Armstrong, this future is not hypothetical. No indeed. It is a business plan they are actively pursuing. It didn't begin in a research university or a medical ethics board. Instead, like many Silicon Valley ventures, it came to life in a WeWork.

Presently, armed with \$30 million in venture capital, *Preventive* claims it intends to develop embryo-editing technologies designed to prevent genetic illnesses. Its co-founder, Lucas Harrington, is trained in CRISPR and has previously worked with Nobel laureate Jennifer Doudna, who helped discover it. To undoubtedly calm the masses, *Preventive* insists it won't hold clinical trials until the technology at hand is "proven safe," but hold on. The framing of "until it's safe" inherently presumes a future where this line will be crossed, suggesting that the only barrier is timing. Seems like a clever way to transform ethical restraints into a temporary delay, while raising the stakes to transcend policy or science into the realm of spiritual or existential. *Preventive* further pushes the ongoing debate over synthetic embryos to the level of metaphysical

and human meaning. Should the use of CRISPR make us feel comfortable with *Preventive's* fast-tracked project? It is essential to be clear about what CRISPR is, because it is not magic, and it is not a cure. It is a molecular scalpel that can cut DNA at specific sites and potentially rewrite what follows next. It works by exploiting a bacterial defense system and has already been used to treat rare blood diseases in adults. What happens when this new-age tool is used to target embryos before life has begun? This matters because gene editing does not just affect one person. The ripple effect is profound, writing genetic code into future generations. Suddenly, medicine as we know it is thrown out the window, to be replaced by designer embryos for the elite. Armstrong, whose net worth, according to Forbes, is \$12.5 billion, remarked that it was correct



to attempt to eliminate preventable diseases, stating: "More than 300 million people globally live with genetic disease. Foundational research should be done to determine if safe and effective therapies can be developed to cure these diseases at birth. It is far easier to correct a smaller number of cells before disease progression occurs, such as in an embryo."

In the blink of an eye, the guiding ethos that should be driving *Preventive* have pivoted from medical humility, that values the sacredness of human life, to the complete technological disruption of it. *Preventive* aims to treat human biology like code, strip it of the essence of life, solve it like a startup problem, and scale it for billions like software. All so they can have superior babies.

Clearly, in their world, there is no waiting for ethical consensus. Instead, it is simply a race to the regulatory gray zone. In this case, the target isn't a specific market. It is much greater; it's the human genome. However, the end product isn't a savvy app. It is a child. Indeed, *Preventive* isn't a social media project, meaning bugs aren't crashes per se. Nope, they are mutations, and like failures, they will be inherited.

So, where is this regulatory gray zone? Because editing embryos for reproduction is illegal in the United States, *Preventive* is reportedly looking abroad for a place to set up shop, including the United Arab Emirates, where the legal environment tends to be more permissive. As previously noted, the company's co-founder, Lucas Harrington, is trained in CRISPR and has worked with Doudna, who helped discover it. What *Preventive* is doing is not

isolated. Altman, Armstrong, Peter Thiel, and Alexis Ohanian—names interchangeable with technology's dystopian boundary—have each invested in a larger network of companies that aim to reshape reproduction itself. These include *Orchid*, *Nucleus Genomics*, and *Herasight*. These outfits offer polygenic risk scores that estimate an embryo's likelihood of developing disease, anxiety, or even scoring higher on intelligence metrics. Parents going through IVF are already being offered "healthier embryo" selection services.

What *Preventive* proposes is simply the next logical step for these deep-state billionaires. Meaning, don't just screen for potential shortcomings—edit them out.

Armstrong tweeted that gene editing could create children "less prone to

heart disease" and with "stronger bones." Sure, that idea sounds practical, maybe even compassionate, but there remains a problem. Undoubtedly, the boundary between therapy and enhancement is not fixed, it is contextual. Think about it. What begins as prevention quickly becomes preference. Once one child is edited to be "resilient," the market incentive shifts. What parent wants to send their unedited child into a world where others are optimized? The frighteningly corrupt reality of this scenario is that none of it makes sense.

In addition to red flags being raised by many, scientists and ethicists have also expressed concern over projects like *Preventive* that aim to rework humanity. Fyodor Urnov of UC Berkeley called the premise of doing so "either lying, delusional, or both." Stanford bioethicist Hank Greely noted that the risk-benefit ratio "sucks at this point," and even Jennifer Doudna has urged restraint. She has repeatedly warned that public trust and rigorous oversight must come before any move toward editing embryos for live births.

This historical warning for the dangerously slippery slope was also heard in 2018 when Chinese scientist He Jiankui edited embryos to

### CNN Claims Fluoride is Safe for Cognition and Possibly Beneficial

A CNN news story gleefully announced **Fluoride in drinking water does not negatively affect cognitive ability — and may actually provide benefit, study finds.**

Benefit? It's 2025, and The Science™ is still debating about whether indiscriminately adding a neurotoxic, bioaccumulating chemical into the public drinking water supply is safe and sound...even beneficial.

The CNN headline was spawned by a new study looking at how children's fluoride exposure is associated with cognition across the life course. The study is presumably in response to the raging debate and ongoing legal battle against the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) to keep the practice of water fluoridation.

Speaking to The HighWire, lead attorney in the case against EPA concerning water fluoridation, Michael Connett stated: "The introduction to this "scientific paper" reads like a press release from the American Dental Association, littered with exaggerated statements about fluoridation's benefits and misleading dismissals of the research indicating harm. One can only hope that the authors did not conduct their study with the same degree of bias that is indicated by their "summary" of prior research."

Speaking more specifically about the new study's potential blind spots, Connett continues: "While the title of the study indicates the authors looked at fluoride "across the life course," they had no data on fluoride exposure from conception through fifth grade — a critical window of time when fluoride's

risks to neurodevelopment is at its zenith."

#### *Evolving Science Meets Legal Action*

In August 2024, the National Toxicology Program (NTP) released its comprehensive systematic review of the research on fluoride and the brain. It identified 72 studies investigating the relationship between fluoride and IQ in human populations, including 19 classified as "high quality." According to NTP, these "high-quality studies (i.e., studies with low potential for bias) consistently demonstrate lower IQ scores with higher fluoride exposure." The NTP thus concluded, "with moderate confidence," that higher fluoride exposure "is consistently associated with lower IQ in children.

Last year, U.S. District Judge Edward Chen in California turned the NTP's scientific momentum into policy action by ordering the EPA to change regulations for fluoride in drinking water, saying the chemical poses an unreasonable potential risk to children at levels that are currently typical nationwide. He ruled that the EPA could pursue a number of options, from a warning label about fluoride's risks at current levels to steps toward tightening restrictions

on its addition to drinking water. "One thing the EPA cannot do, however, in the face of this Court's finding, is to ignore that risk," he wrote.

Lee Zeldin's EPA and U.S. Attorney General Pam Bondi appealed the decision and are currently engaged in a legal battle to overturn Judge Chen's ruling and preserve the status quo on water fluoridation. A bizarre and unpopular move in direct opposition to Kennedy's directive at HHS and the MAHA agenda, which voted in leaders to end the chronic disease epidemic. Despite Zeldin, Bondi, and the EPA's fluoride foot-dragging, the legal battles and investigations are moving forward against industry with fury.

#### *Industry In The Crosshairs*

In May, Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton opened civil probes into both Procter & Gamble and Colgate, stating: "...toothpaste manufacturers continue to flavor their products and deceptively market them in ways that encourage kids to ingest fluoride toothpaste and mislead their parents to use far more than the safe and recommended amount of fluoride toothpaste."

Colgate resolved its probe in Sep-

tember by agreeing to depict "safe, age-appropriate amounts of toothpaste" on packaging for its Colgate, Tom's of Maine, and hello products. Meanwhile, an Illinois district court judge ruled Procter & Gamble can be sued over Kid's Crest toothpaste packaging for misleading consumers about fluoride safety.

The real science to inform true change via legal avenues is underway. As the challenge is being put to longtime industry influence, corporate media gatekeepers and willful government apathy, cracks in the fluoridated house of cards are appearing. Industry is being forced to defend its 'safe and effective' position for the practice of water fluoridation against the evolving science on fluoride and the brain... and is losing.





### The Campbell's Soup Scandal: Leaked Rant Ignites Consumer Fury

In a bombshell revelation that has rocked the food industry, Campbell Soup Company's Vice President of Information Technology, Martin Bally, was allegedly caught in a leaked audio recording making explosive claims about the company's iconic chicken noodle soup. The recording, released as part of a lawsuit filed by former employee Robert Garza, claims to capture Bally in an expletive-laden rant disparaging the product and admitting to what he described as the use of "bioengineered meat" sourced from 3D printing technology.

"Bioengineered meat — I don't wanna eat a f\*\*\*ing piece of chicken that came from a 3D printer," Bally allegedly stated, while confessing he avoids consuming the soup himself. These admissions have sparked widespread disgust among consumers, who view the idea of 3D-printed meat as unnatural and unappetizing, leading to viral backlash on social media and calls for boycotts.

The scandal unfolded when Garza (suing Campbell's for unrelated issues) publicized the hour-long conversation recorded without Bally's knowledge. In it, Bally not only questioned the quality of the chicken but also made derogatory remarks about the company's workforce and labeled its products as "highly processed food" for "poor people." The audio quickly spread across platforms like X and Instagram, amassing millions of views and fueling memes that mocked the brand's wholesome image. Campbell's stock took a hit, dropping amid the uproar, as shoppers expressed revulsion at the thought of printer-produced proteins in their pantry staples.



Campbell's swiftly responded, placing Bally on temporary leave and launching an internal investigation. In an official statement, the company condemned the remarks: "If the comments heard on the audio recording were in fact made by Mr. Bally, they are unacceptable. Such language does not reflect our values and the culture of our company. We do not tolerate that kind of language under any circumstances." They further dismissed the claims about their products as "not only inaccurate—they are patently absurd," emphasizing that "the chicken meat in our soups comes from long-trusted, USDA-approved U.S. suppliers and meets our high quality standards. All our soups are made with No Antibiotics Ever chicken meat. Any claims to the contrary are completely false." The statement also noted that Bally, being in IT, "has nothing to do with how we make our food," underscoring the disconnect between his role and production processes.

The fallout extended beyond public opinion, prompting regulatory scrutiny. Florida Attorney General James Uthmeier announced an investigation on November 25, 2025, threatening to "shut down" operations if violations were found, citing the state's 2024 ban on lab-grown meat.

This has raised questions about the legality of using 3D-printed or cultivated meat in food products. Federally, such practices have been approved under FDA and USDA oversight since 2023, but several states have imposed strict bans. Florida and Alabama prohibit sales and manufacturing, with Mississippi and South Dakota enacting similar restrictions in 2025, making violations punishable by fines or imprisonment. Texas joined as the seventh state in June 2025, banning lab-grown meat entirely. Other states like Arizona and Ohio enforce labeling laws that could lead to penalties for misrepresenting such products as traditional meat. If Bally's recorded claims prove to be true, Campbell's could face severe legal repercussions in these jurisdictions, including shutdowns and hefty fines.

resist HIV. He was jailed for his work, and a global moratorium followed. Yet here we are today. ### How to Use Contract Law to Protect Yourself — Even in Medicine

When you walk into a hospital, clinic, or pharmacy, you're often handed a clipboard filled with forms you're expected to sign without question. "Just standard paperwork," they say. In reality, every one of those signatures is a contract — and under contract law, what you agree to can have enormous consequences for your rights, your privacy, and your health choices.

In her powerful article "Blanket Informed Consent for Biologics," Dr. Sherri Tenpenny warned that many of these so-called "informed consent" forms are anything but informed. They often use vague, sweeping language that gives medical institutions — and the corporations behind them — permission to administer treatments, share data, or assume authority far beyond what most people realize.

So what can you do? The answer lies in understanding how contract law works — and how to preserve your rights in every agreement you sign, from a car purchase to a medical release form.

#### 1. Every Signature Creates a Binding Relationship

Under contract law, a signature is more than ink on paper, it's an acknowledgment of consent. Whether you're signing a mortgage, a phone contract, or a hospital intake form, that signature says: "I understand and agree to the terms."

The first principle of protection is simple but powerful: Never sign anything you don't fully understand. In medicine, that means you have the right — legally and ethically — to: Request a copy of every form before signing it. Ask questions about each clause and its implications. Cross out, initial, or modify any line that doesn't align

with your informed consent.

If a clinic refuses to honor your right to read or adjust what you're signing, that itself is a red flag. True consent cannot be coerced or concealed. You have the right — legally and ethically — to...Cross out, initial, or modify any line that doesn't align with your informed consent.

#### 2. "Informed Consent" Is a Contract — Not a Courtesy

The term informed consent sounds protective, but in practice it's often used as a shield for liability. When you sign a form that says you've been "informed of the risks," it usually serves to protect the provider — not you. That doesn't mean medical professionals are your enemies. It means you must approach all paperwork as what it is: a binding legal instrument governed by the same principles that apply to any contract — capacity, consideration, clarity, and consent.

#### 4 C's Before signing:

**Capacity:** Are you of sound mind and not under duress?

**Consideration:** Is there a fair exchange — in this case, services for payment or treatment?

**Clarity:** Are the terms unambiguous and specific?

**Consent:** Are you freely agreeing without manipulation or pressure?

If any of these are missing, the agreement is flawed and potentially voidable.

#### 3. Reserve Your Rights: Without Prejudice

When you sign anything — particularly in environments where consent feels rushed or standardized — you can preserve your rights by signing your name: "your signature, without prejudice." This simple notation means you do not waive any legal remedies or constitutional rights, even as you proceed with the transaction.

It prevents the assumption that your signature equals unconditional consent to every hidden clause or policy buried in the fine print. While this line doesn't automatically override unlawful behavior, it provides a clear record that you signed under reservation of

rights, not blind acceptance.

#### 4. Modify Contracts to Reflect True Consent

You are not required to accept a contract "as-is." If a hospital's form includes vague authorizations like:

"I consent to any and all treatments deemed necessary by my provider."

You can cross out that line and write:

"I consent only to specific procedures that have been explained and agreed to." Then initial the change next to it. If the office refuses your alteration, ask them to note your refusal and sign that acknowledgment instead.

The key principle: your consent must be specific, informed, and voluntary — or it isn't valid. This same principle applies to other industries: employment, finance, real estate, even digital platforms that request sweeping permissions. The difference is awareness.

#### 5. Put Your Biometrics in a Trust: The Ultimate Layer of Protection

When you place your biometrics—your face geometry, fingerprints, iris pattern, voiceprint, DNA, and even your digital likeness—into a private irrevocable trust, you convert them from "personal identifiers" the system claims it can collect by implied consent into private property owned by a separate legal person.

That single move collapses the entire premise of blanket consent for biologics, scans, and digital surveillance, because neither the airport, the clinic, nor a corporation can lawfully take or store trust property without the trustee's explicit written authorization. Any unauthorized biometric capture becomes a trespass against the trust, not a vague privacy complaint—and the burden shifts to the collector to prove they have jurisdiction over a private trust, which they almost never do. This is where true sovereignty begins. It's not about rejecting society or medical care — it's about understanding jurisdiction, consent, and control.

#### 7. Practical Steps Before You Sign Any Form

Here's your quick checklist before you put pen to paper or stylus to tablet:

1. Read every word — especially the small print and footnotes.
2. Ask for definitions of vague phrases like "biologics," "treatment," or "services rendered."
3. Cross out what you do not consent to, and initial the change.
4. Sign with reservation of rights (without prejudice) if you feel pressured or unsure.

### “He Who Controls the Weather Controls the World” - The Truth About Geoengineering, Highlights

TFPF Staff Recap of the recent interview of Dane Wigington by Tucker Carlson has generated notable attention due to its controversial discussion of geoengineering and climate manipulation, commonly referred to as “chemtrails”. The exchange aired on November 10, 2025. Dane Wigington (founder of GeoEngineeringWatch.org) detailed secret government programs and their impact on weather, ecosystems, and public health.

##### Legislative Action

Wigington stated that 36 state legislatures are considering or have passed measures to ban geoengineering, with Tennessee and Florida already enacting restrictions. He indicated ongoing efforts to inform lawmakers about the nature and

scope of these operations.

##### Wildfires and Biological Tests

During the conversation, Wigington claimed the government has used “climate engineering” as a weapon, even implicating wildfires and biological warfare programs conducted without public consent as extensions of these activities.

##### Notable Claims

Wigington emphasized the lack of transparency and oversight over such technologies. He contended the environmental movement has been reticent in challenging these efforts out of concern for maintaining nonprofit status and funding, according to his discussions with legal representatives from groups like Greenpeace and Sierra Club.

He suggested coal fly ash is used as a base material for dispersal,

offering plausible deniability and a convenient method for disposal by industries.

References were made to historical weather control operations, including “Operation Popeye,” tying past military-led weather modification efforts to current geoengineering practices.

##### Public Reception and Critique

The interview has drawn both support and skepticism. While some see Wigington’s claims as whistleblowing on critical environmental issues, others argue these theories lack robust scientific verification and are often dismissed as conspiracy. Nonetheless, Carlson’s platform provided significant visibility, highlighting both the controversy and public interest in government transparency regarding climate intervention technologies.

Dane Wigington’s interview with Tucker Carlson centered on claims of covert geoengineering programs adversely affecting global weather and ecological health, and the need for legislative action and public attention to these alleged government activities.

### Venezuela Could be the Neocons' Ticket Back to Power

MAGA is riding high these days, convinced they've finally exorcised the neoconservatives who controlled the Republican Party for decades. Supposedly gone are the days of endless wars in Iraq and Afghanistan, the trillion-dollar boondoggles sold as "spreading democracy"? Trump promised to drain that swamp, and his base believes he's done it—putting America First and mocking the old guard like John McCain and Liz Cheney.

I hate to burst that bubble, but the neocons are far from dead. At best they're playing possum. President Trump's looming military action against Venezuela could be their golden ticket back to power, co-opting the very movement that thought it had buried them.

Let's start with the obvious: the demise of the neocons has been greatly exaggerated. Sure, their poster boys like Jeb Bush or Mitt Romney couldn't win a presidential primary at the moment. However, look who has staffed both Trump's administrations. Mike Pompeo, the quintessential neocon hawk, served as Secretary of State the last time, pushing regime change agendas from Iran to North Korea.

Now we've got Marco Rubio in the same spot, a guy who's never met a foreign entanglement he didn't like. Rubio's been a darling of the interventionist crowd since his Senate days, advocating for arming Syrian rebels and toppling dictators throughout the Middle East. Trump himself has been more restrained—no full-scale invasions on his watch yet—but that's a far cry from the drastic change some in MAGA envisioned.

Trump hasn't decreased overseas troop deployment on net whatsoever



and the Pentagon budget has risen significantly in both of his administrations. As for Rubio, he's trying to sound as America First as he can while serving the current boss but make no mistake: the push for action in Venezuela reeks of his influence, along with other holdovers like Elliott Abrams, who's been knee-deep in Latin American meddling since the Reagan era. Throw in unconditional support for Israel's wars, and you've got essentially a new Bush administration disguised as America First.

We must also remember that MAGA isn't monolithic. There's a vocal antiwar segment who support voices like Rand Paul or Tucker Carlson, warning that boots on the ground in Caracas would betray everything Trump ran on. However, the polls tell a different story: a clear majority of Trump supporters back military intervention in Venezuela. According to a recent CBS News/YouGov survey, 66% of MAGA Republicans favor U.S. military action there, compared to just 47% of non-MAGA Republicans.

Overall American support hovers around 20%, but within the GOP base, it's Trump's framing as a quick hit against drugs and migration that's winning the day. If this operation goes like George H.W. Bush's 1989 invasion of Panama—swift, low casualties, Noriega in cuffs and headlines blaring victory—watch what happens. Bush's approval skyrocketed to 80%, and it solidified a bloc of Republican voters hungry for more "decisive" action.

Panama was sold as anti-drug and pro-democracy, just like Venezuela today. A short, "successful" war could lure many America First voters back to the pre-Trump era, where every problem abroad demanded a military solution. The antiwar minority would be ridiculed and shouted down as having been wrong to doubt Trump, and the party would inch closer to its old interventionist self.

Part of the problem is that Trump's anti-war platform was never as radical as the true American First crowd would like to believe. He talks a good game about ending "forever wars," but he doesn't question the core of the empire—the global standing army, the 800-plus bases warehousing hundreds of thousands of troops overseas, and the non-defensive use of them, as long as the war isn't a "forever war."

During his first term, the neocons in his cabinet persuaded him to bomb Syria twice based on dubious claims of chemical attacks by Assad on his own people. Was that an attack on America? Nope. It was classic neocon moralizing to win support for a regime change Israel wanted. Those troops stayed in Syria under the flimsy pretext of "protecting oil fields," but really to support the regime change finally ticked off under Biden. Trump didn't start new wars, but he didn't really end the old ones either, despite his vociferous claims, and his base mostly gave him a pass.

Venezuela fits right into that pattern. Trump's been gunning for regime

change there since the early days of his first term, supporting neocon puppet Juan Guaidó as the "real president" after Maduro's sham election in 2018. At Trump's direction, Washington froze assets, imposed sanctions, and even floated military options back then.

It all fizzled when Guaidó couldn't muster the muscle to oust Maduro, but the intent was clear: topple a socialist dictator, install a friendly government, and claim a win for "democracy." Sound familiar? It's the same script from Iraq to Libya, and now it's back on the table, with warships in the Caribbean and talk of arresting Maduro on drug charges.

Then there's the China angle, where MAGA is already primed for neocon co-optation. Trump's base is all in on antagonism toward Beijing—tariffs, tech bans, and a confrontational military posture. Even the antiwar elements see China as the "real threat," a rising power that Washington must "contain" to protect Americans.

China isn't a military menace; they're just getting richer because they abandoned communism and aren't squandering trillions on policing the globe. They've got one overseas base—Djibouti—while the U.S. has over 800, with over 200,000 troops staffing them. While by no means a laissez faire free market, neither is the U.S.. China's growth is market-driven, not conquest-driven. Yet MAGA's buying the hype, setting the stage for a new Cold War, complete with proxy fights in Taiwan or the South China Sea.

Venezuela could be the gateway drug: intervene there under the guise of fighting drugs and socialism, and suddenly containing China looks like the next logical step.

We also can't ignore the other

In stark contrast to his customary anti-UN rhetoric, Donald Trump has praised the UN Security Council for its endorsement of a new peace plan for Gaza and the Middle East. His Truth Social post reads: “Congratulations to the World on the incredible Vote of the United Nations Security Council, just moments ago, acknowledging and endorsing the BOARD OF PEACE, which will be chaired by me, and include the most powerful and respected Leaders throughout the World. This will go down as one of the biggest approvals in the History of the United Nations, will lead to further Peace all over the World, and is a moment of true Historic proportion! Thank you to the United Nations, and all of the Countries on the U.N. Security Council, China, Russia, France, The United Kingdom, Algeria, Denmark, Greece, Guyana, South Korea, Pakistan, Panama, Sierra Leone, Slovenia, and Somalia. Also thank you to those Countries that weren’t on this Committee, but strongly backed the effort, including Qatar, Egypt, United Arab Emirates, The Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, Indonesia, Turkey, and Jordan. The UN, for its part, is “prepared to play ‘any role’ needed to advance the breakthrough Security Council resolution endorsing the United States-led Gaza peace plan,” according to UN Deputy Spokesman Farhan Haq, cited in a UN news release, which continued: “Although

the UN has no defined role in either finalizing the Board of Peace chaired by President Trump — which will oversee the transition and reconstruction of Gaza — or the planned stabilization force, Mr. Haq said the UN was “committed to implementing the roles entrusted to it in the resolution.”

It is tasked with scaling up humanitarian assistance for stricken civilians across the Strip following more than two years of war between Hamas and Israeli forces “and supporting all efforts to move the parties toward the next phase of the ceasefire.” The Council endorsed the US peace plan and a temporary international force for Gaza by 13-0 on Monday [November 17], with Russia and China abstaining.”

The specific action is UN Security Council Resolution 2803, which makes clear from the language that it regards itself as the ultimate source of all

authority for what happens in the Middle East. The resolution authorizes not only the creation of a Board of Peace, but also a “temporary International Stabilization Force.” In practice, of course, this will mean, as with all other international peacekeeping efforts authorized by the UN Security Council, from the Korean Peninsula to Cyprus to Iraq, that the supreme command will be the UN, not, as Trump seems to imagine, the American president. If past is a precedent, we can soon

priorities deep in the party. Put it all together, and MAGA looks like ripe fruit for the picking. If Trump green-lights war in Venezuela, the loyalists who back him no matter what will turn on the antiwar skeptics, ridiculing them as disloyal doubters of “dear leader.” Success breeds amnesia; a quick win erases promises of restraint. The next Republican contender—J.D. Vance or whoever—could run on Trump’s immigration and trade toughness but

expect blue-helmeted troops to begin patrolling Gaza and perhaps other contested territories in Israel and Palestine. We can only wonder what the other “exciting announcements” in coming weeks will entail.

While Trump is to be commended for his many actions opposing the UN and the globalist agenda, such as withdrawing the U.S. from the Paris climate accord and from the World Health Organization, and for boycotting various globalist events, such as the ongoing COP30 climate conference in Brazil, his commendable interest in securing peace between warring countries is something that the globalists can turn to their advantage. Trump has made no secret of wanting to be known as the “peace president” — a desire that

UN globalists can harness to their own benefit, if Trump gives them an opening.

It bears mentioning that there’s nothing amiss in an American president using

his good offices to help negotiate peace between third parties. It becomes constitutionally problematic, however, the moment that negotiations give way to foreign aid, military commitments, and the like. What Trump seems to envisage for Gaza is some kind of U.S. military presence, along with the usual “aid packages.” Any sort of “Marshall Plan for Palestine” should be opposed, not only on “America First,” but on constitutional grounds as well.

ditch the antiwar lip service entirely. Before you know it, we’re back to a full-blown Cold War 2.0, this time against China, with proxy wars galore to “contain” them, just like the old days with Russia.

The neocons don’t need to win elections outright; they just need to infiltrate and redirect. Venezuela isn’t just a sideshow—it’s their pathway back to the driver’s seat. **MAGA must wake up before it’s too late.**

Last week's surprise release of a draft Ukraine war peace plan has raised hopes that the nearly three-year bloody conflict may finally come to an end. Ukraine has suffered horrible losses that may change the demographics of that country for decades to come.

If this peace plan can be negotiated in a way that satisfies all sides and the guns finally go silent, I will be the first to cheer. However, the continued failure to understand the nature and origin of the current conflict leaves me skeptical that a real peace can be reached this way.

From the Orange Revolution in the early 2000s to the Maidan revolution in 2014, the US and its NATO partners have been interfering in Ukraine's internal affairs in an attempt to manipulate the country into a hostile position toward its much larger and more powerful neighbor, Russia.

We must remember how directly coordinated the 2014 coup was by

## Trump Defends Proposal for 600,000 Chinese Student Visas

President Donald Trump is defending his proposal to offer a record 600,000 visas to Chinese students.

In an interview with Fox News' Laura Ingraham last week, Trump stated, "We do have a lot of people coming in from China. We always have, China and other countries. We also have a massive system of colleges and universities. And if we were to cut that in half, which perhaps makes some people happy, you would have half the colleges in the United States go out of business." Trump advocated importing more H1-B workers into the United States, despite signing a proclamation in

September to do the opposite.

Fox News reports: "The remarks mark a reversal from earlier this year, when the Trump administration said it would 'aggressively revoke' Chinese student visas amid espionage concerns. In August, Trump changed course and announced plans to expand the program dramatically.

More than 277,000 Chinese students studied in the U.S. during the 2023–2024 school year, according to the Institute of International Education

— the second-largest foreign student

population after India. That figure is down from a peak of over 372,000 in 2019–2020.

The comments come as the State Department

has intensified its visa crackdown, revoking more than 80,000 nonimmigrant visas — including about 8,000 student visas — since the start of Trump's term. Officials say many were revoked over criminal activity or participation in rallies against U.S. support for Israel."



Although immigration policy — specifically, reducing both illegal and legal migration — has been one of the bright spots of Trump's second term, the president has occasionally contradicted his administration's own policies by advocating increased legal migration to the United States, as he did during his first term.

In addition to the broader dangers of mass migration, increasing the number of Chinese student visas would give Communist China an opportunity to expand its theft of U.S. research and technology. Rather than go along with such a proposal, Congress should adopt a true "America First" migration policy and end mass migration into the United States.

### Things They Didn't Teach You in Church:

A few months ago, it was Equity, now the politically driven media buzzword is *affordability*. Just as Equity didn't mean Equality, *affordability* doesn't mean Cost of Living although the Left and their lamestream media would like you to think it does. *Affordability* doesn't revolve around what something costs, it has more to do with a person's situation in life and their economic position. Does a person have a job? Do they qualify for food stamps? How many dependent children are in the family? These are just a few things that determine *affordability*; it is even more complicated than that. What kind of a job do you have? Where do you live? What kind of lifestyle are you accustomed to? *Affordability* varies person to person. How *affordable* is this economy for a 24-year-old in New York City working at McDonalds? How *affordable* is this economy for a 24-year-old in Quartzsite, Arizona working at McDonalds? How *affordable* is this economy for a 24-year-old single mother of two anywhere in this country? How *affordable* is this economy for a 24-year-old illegal immigrant anywhere in this country? The answer will be different in each situation.

Illegal immigration drove up *affordability* for all Americans during the Biden administration; it is called inflation. Biden-omics drove up inflation at a rate of over 9% every year during those 4 years. The dirty little secret is inflation usually always goes up, and prices never go back to where they were before. Trump, by lowering energy costs (which affects the cost of everything else) might be able to drive overall

prices down some. If the price of gas gets below \$2 per gallon again, we may see the price of many things drop. Would \$2 per gallon gas make the economy more *affordable* for most Americans? Probably, but it would lower the cost of living in general. However, a person's *affordability* depends on a lot more than the cost of gas.

A Sage Economics study found 9.1% of Gen Z men, those born between 1997 and 2012 are unemployed, that is more than twice the national average. Researchers surveyed 2,080 US adults, over the age of 18, and explored their attitudes, behaviors and motivations surrounding savings, investing and utilizing payment methods. This study found that Gen Z consumers prefer using plastic over tangible legal tenders. "Nearly a third (29%) believe that people who pay with cash are either out of touch or cringe..." If you are wondering, cringe is not good. It is hard to believe but with Gen Z'ers,



cash is not cool! Those born between 1997 and 2012 also have a hard time showing up for work. At some point a person who doesn't think they need to show up for work should realize their job is what we call non-essential. Many Gen Z'ers can't get their face out of their phones, even at work! In 2023, almost 20% of adults aged 25 to 34 were living in a parent's home. Over 50%, most young adults living with a parent, say the arrangement is good for *af-*


*fordability*. No kidding!

The Book of Proverbs has a lot to say about the attitudes we see in a lot of our younger citizens. In **Proverbs 6:6** we are told *Go to the ant, thou sluggard; consider her ways, and be wise: Proverbs 10: 4 He becometh poor that dealeth with a slack hand: but the hand of the diligent maketh rich. 5 He that gathereth in summer is a wise son: but he that sleepeth in harvest is a son that causeth shame.* Also, in several

other places such as **Proverbs 12: 11, Proverbs 13: 4, Proverbs 14: 23, and Proverbs 19: 15** God warns His children about laziness and the effect it will have on *Affordability*. Also, in the New Testament God addresses how His children should approach jobs and employers. In **Colossians 3: 22** God instructs us Servants, *obey in all things your masters according to the flesh; not with eyeservice, as menpleasers; but in singleness of heart, fearing God 23 And whatsoever ye do, do it heartily, as to the Lord, and not unto men;* As God fearing Christians we should be loyal to our employers and do what we can to help them succeed.

Then in **1 Timothy 5: 8** God's children are warned about the consequences of not being a worthwhile employee who provides for their dependents; *But if any provide not for his own, and specially for those of his own house, he hath denied the faith, and is worse than an infidel.* If you are still living in your parents' home, you have probably not begun the process of building your own individual *affordability*. I am afraid many of the youth of America will soon face a fu-

ture they are totally unprepared for. If a person is unable or unwilling to responsibly hold a job and do the things required to keep that job, that person will eventually have a serious *affordability* problem.

Politically, I think Trump has handled this masterfully, turning this issue back on the radical left. Trump's position is that the Biden administration caused this problem through their "open border" policies, increasing interest rates, and causing the housing shortage, linking these problems in one way or another to the invasion of illegal immigrants. In a Fox News interview, Agriculture Secretary Brooke Rollins said that the American dream is making a comeback under the Trump administration, and "real relief" was coming "very soon." Trump has linked "*affordability*" to the rising "Cost of Living", and the increases all traces back to the democrats and the Biden administration. ### Greetings La Paz County

The County Assessor's office hopes you had a very Happy Thanksgiving! We have been busy addressing taxpayers' questions and needs. With the tax bills being issued last month, we received an increase in traffic and phone calls.

Every year all property owners receive a Notice of Value (NOV). The real property NOV's are sent out within the first quarter of each year and the personal property NOV's are set out in the third quarter of each year. This notice allows all taxpayers to appeal the classification or the Full Cash Value (FCV) of their property.

I wanted to bring your attention to the information on the 2nd page, specifically the bottom paragraph

regarding Rental Property.

If the property listed on the NOV is being used as a rental residence as defined in Arizona Revised Statutes A.R.S. § 42-12004 you are required to register the property as a rental with the County Assessor pursuant to A.R.S. § 33-1902 of Rental Residential Law. Failure to do so may subject you to a penalty. Per A.R.S § 33-1902.1 - The County Assessor's office will be collecting a fee of \$10 for all rental registrants' applications.

The Assessor's office provides many ways to obtain a copy of the Registration of Arizona Residential Rental Property form (82901). Please visit the La Paz county website ([www.lapaz.gov](http://www.lapaz.gov)), make

your way to the Assessor's page, and click on the Assessor Forms section. You can contact our office, and we can email you a fillable copy. Also, you can stop into the office to pick up a form to fill out. Please feel free to mail back or drop off your application and payment to the County Assessor's office. You may pay the application fee by any of the following methods: cash, check, money order, or cashier's check. The ability to pay by credit card is coming soon!

#### WHO Pandemic Agreement

On December 1, 2025, the fourth meeting of the Intergovernmental Working Group on the WHO Pandemic Agreement opened in Geneva in a hybrid format. Member States began detailed negotiations on the Pathogen Access and Benefit Sharing (PABS) annex, which will govern how pathogen samples and genetic data are shared and how benefits like vaccines and diagnostics are distributed. Talks focus on converting broad principles agreed in May 2025 into binding obligations, including fair access for low- and middle-income countries and accountability for industry and wealthy states, while civil society groups press for stronger equity guarantees.

#### A Looming Mexican Coup


Mexico's escalating violence increasingly resembles a low-intensity internal war, as cartels like Sinaloa and Jalisco New Generation act like insurgent forces using armored vehicles, IEDs, drones, and paramilitary tactics to control territory and politics. Analysts say these groups effectively dominate about a third of the country, fueling extreme levels of killings, kidnappings, and disappearances and feeding U.S. fears over fentanyl, migration, and cross-border attacks. Some U.S. voices now float labeling cartels as terrorist organizations and even using U.S. military force, warning that a spectacular incident spilling over the border could shatter U.S.-Mexico relations and turn the narco-conflict into an overt international showdown.

#### COP 30 – Future Climate Summit

Alex Newman portrays COP 30 and related UN climate summits as part of a deceptive “climate agenda” aimed at economically weakening the United States and empowering global governance and rival powers like China, rather than protecting the environment. He frames climate policy as a spiritual and ideological struggle over sovereignty, freedom, and biblical values, and says the agenda could be stopped if President Trump withdraws the U.S. from the UN Framework Convention on Climate Change, undermining the legal basis for COP deals.

#### The Autopen Pardons

Former Overstock CEO Patrick Byrne claims Michelle Obama used President Joe Biden's autopen to issue controversial last-minute pardons while Biden was politically and physically weakened, casting her as part of a hidden Obama-aligned network wielding illicit control over presidential powers. Representative Marjorie Taylor Greene uses this alleged “autopen scandal” to argue that any Fauci pardon was invalid without Trump's explicit authorization, saying this clears the way for new investigations, prosecution, or a special prosecutor under Trump's restored administration, though there is no public evidence a valid Fauci pardon has been revoked or that a prosecution has started.



#### Complete Financial Lockdown

Peter Koenig and Whitney Webb describe an emerging “control grid” that fuses cash limits, CBDCs, digital IDs, and biometrics to let authorities monitor and condition access to money. They argue policies that restrict cash and push digital payments, backed by institutions like the BIS, IMF, and WEF, are less about efficiency and more about enabling programmable money, blacklisting, and real-time financial surveillance, citing examples like frozen accounts during the Canadian trucker protests to warn that basic participation in society could be tied to obedience.

#### Covid-19 Vaccine Dangers

One peer-reviewed study cited by commentators reports fibrinolysis-resistant amyloid microclots in all vaccinated participants in a small cohort, including “healthy controls,” with especially dense clots in those with long-lasting post-vaccine symptoms. The authors and commentators say this suggests spike-protein exposure from vaccination alone might drive persistent clotting and warrants urgent regulatory investigation, though independent reviews note that microclots are linked to long COVID and inflammation and that mainstream experts do not accept that current evidence proves a universal vaccine-driven microclot problem in all vaccinated people. In a Daily Pulse segment, Dr. Suzanne Humphries expands this into a broader claim that vaccines—especially COVID-era mRNA shots—are tools of a technocratic, transhumanist project involving genomic integration, intelligence-linked bioweapons concepts, and future systems tying access to money and movement to one's biomedical profile, claims that mainstream scientific bodies reject.

#### Infant Hep B Vaccine Debate

At a September 2025 ACIP meeting, the CDC postponed a decision on whether to delay the routine hepatitis B birth dose for babies whose moth-



ers test negative, signaling an unusual opening to revisit the decades-old recommendation. Critics argue most newborns face low hepatitis B risk and want more safety data, while mainstream medical groups stress that the birth dose has driven a greater than 99% drop in infant hepatitis B and remains vital to guard against undisclosed maternal or caregiver transmission.

#### Ukraine Peace Deal

A leaked report claims the U.S. is crafting a 28-point Ukraine peace roadmap largely behind closed doors, with an unnamed EU diplomat saying European governments have been kept in the dark to prevent further leaks. The alleged U.S. plan would have Ukraine renounce NATO membership and drop claims to Crimea and Donbass in exchange for a settlement with Russia, prompting EU states and the UK to draft a counter-proposal that Moscow dismissed as “completely unconstructive,” while Russian officials portray the war as a Western proxy campaign and signal willingness to give written security assurances to the EU.

#### Big Brother is Watching

Reporters uncovered a leaked database from the Jakarta-based surveillance firm First Wap, showing its Altamides system captured about 1.5 million phone location records worldwide from 2007 to 2014, tracking high-profile figures, dissidents, and people near elections and protests in multiple countries. An undercover team later met executives at a secretive trade fair, where the company, despite claiming to serve only vetted governments, discussed using fronts and offshore paperwork to work around export controls and sanctions, underscoring how weak telecom security and regulation make global phone tracking widely exploitable.

#### Police Shot in Arizona

On November 21, 2025, a pre-dawn traffic stop near Douglas, Arizona, turned into an ambush when gunmen allegedly opened fire on officers, riddling a patrol SUV with bullets and seriously wounding at least one officer before fleeing into the desert. After a manhunt involving drones, K-9 units, and federal agencies, police arrested two teenagers, including a 17-year-old Mexican national who had entered illegally, and charged them with attempted first-degree murder and related offenses; the case is now central to national border-security arguments.

#### Orangewood Elementary Assault

On November 18, 2025, a man slipped into Phoenix's Orangewood Elementary School through an unlocked door alongside a tardy student and allegedly lured a 10-year-old girl into an empty classroom by claiming he was a doctor. Police say he sexually assaulted her until she escaped, triggering a lockdown and a rapid investigation that led to the arrest of 25-year-old Liberian immigrant Abel Kai Gblah, a registered sex offender with prior convictions who was on lifetime probation, prompting outrage over security and supervision failures.

#### Hard to Digest

Pediatrician Michelle Perro links a surge in children with chronic digestive issues since the early 2000s to the spread of genetically modified crops and glyphosate-based herbicides, citing reported symptom improvements when families switch to organic, non-GMO foods. The article describes mechanisms by which glyphosate could harm gut health—microbiome disruption, enzyme damage, impaired motility, “leaky gut,” and mineral chelation—and urges a precautionary approach, especially for formula-fed infants, favoring organic, whole foods while further research continues.

#### The Epstein Files Released

On November 19, 2025, President Donald Trump signed the bipartisan

Epstein Files Transparency Act, which passed the House 427–1 and the Senate by unanimous consent and orders the Justice Department to release all non-classified Epstein-related documents online within 30 days. The law also requires unredacted lists of government officials and “politically exposed persons” named in the files to go to key congressional committees. Survivors and transparency advocates welcome the move as long-overdue accountability, while political actors brace for fallout; some commentators now claim the released “Epstein files” prove Epstein served Mossad, the Rothschilds, and the British royal family in a global blackmail network at the core of a “satanic pedophile globalist” system, allegations far beyond what mainstream institutions acknowledge.

Commentators seizing on the “Epstein files” now claim they prove Epstein worked as an asset not only for Israel's Mossad but also for the Rothschild banking dynasty and the British royal family, orchestrating a worldwide sexual blackmail network. In this narrative, the documents expose a “satanic pedophile globalist” system using kompromat to control political and financial elites, and mainstream media and U.S. intelligence are depicted as scrambling to contain revelations that allegedly show deep collusion between Western leaders, Israeli intelligence, and transnational finance.

#### Comey Indictment

In a Virginia case against former FBI Director James Comey, Justice Department lawyers admitted that the full grand jury never saw the final indictment version filed in court, only an earlier draft. Comey's defense argues this procedural flaw

shows the prosecution is defective and politically driven by Attorney General Pam Bondi and President Trump, while the judge closely questions how such a departure from standard grand jury practice occurred and whether it violated Comey's constitutional rights.

#### Thanks Tampon Tim

Reports based on City Journal allege that large sums from Minnesota's welfare programs, including Housing Stabilization Services, were stolen via Somali-run fraud schemes and routed through hawala networks to the terror group al-Shabaab, though the exact amounts and timelines remain unclear. Federal prosecutors have charged eight people, six of Somali descent, with fraud linked to the housing program, and Governor Tim Walz's administration shut that program down on October 31 citing “widespread fraud,” fueling criticism of oversight and vetting.

#### Trump pressures Honduras

President Donald Trump announced a full U.S. pardon for former Honduran president Juan Orlando Hernández, serving a 45-year sentence for drug-trafficking ties, calling his punishment unfair. In the same Truth Social comments, Trump strongly endorsed Hernández ally Nasry “Tito” Asfura and warned that U.S. aid would dry up if Asfura loses, effectively tying American political and financial support to a conservative victory and pressuring Honduran voters.

#### Who is funding WHO

A BMJ review cited in the piece argues the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation's large, earmarked funding has heavily tilted WHO priorities toward polio vaccination at the expense of broader needs like sanitation and non-communicable diseases. It notes that most of Gates-linked funding to WHO goes to infectious disease and nearly 60% to polio, even though paralytic polio is now rare and many recent outbreaks are vaccine-derived, and says investments in clean water and sanitation could more effectively cut polio and many other illnesses. The article frames WHO's reliance on

private donors and Gates's influence as evidence of conflicts of interest and structural corruption.

#### Klaus Schwab

Dan Dicks portrays Klaus Schwab's “Intelligent Age” initiative and Schwab Academy as soft-power tools to socialize elites into accepting a technocratic future with AI-driven governance, digital IDs, ESG scoring, and centralized stakeholder capitalism. He argues that upbeat language about “reskilling” and “global citizenship” masks an agenda to normalize a digital control system where speech, behavior, and consumption can be monitored and steered.

#### A Must See Documentary

The documentary “Age of Disclosure” is presented as evidence of an 80-year global cover-up of non-human craft, recovered bodies, and reverse-engineered alien technology now allegedly weaponized against humanity. Featuring high-profile officials and researchers, it claims defense contractors and “deep state” actors have hidden exotic technologies, staged fake abductions, and may prepare a false-flag alien invasion, while a companion Substack essay blends ET contact claims, CIA psychic programs, and fears that technocrats guided by a future super-AI are steering humanity toward transhumanist tyranny and possible extinction. two British-accented men posing as “Alliance for Sustainable Protein” advocates allegedly filmed attendees while pushing an AI-generated fake study saying “fake meat causes autism.” Brownstone’s Jeffrey Tucker later concluded it was likely a sting designed to depict health-freedom activists as scientifically gullible, after his team linked the operation, via site code, to the UK-based Centre for Climate Reporting funded by major NGOs. He argues this reflects a broader, well-resourced effort aligned with pharmaceutical interests to discredit RFK Jr. and vaccine- and food-safety movements.

### O’Keefe GAO Vaccine Data Sting

On November 26, 2025, The HighWire published a piece on James O’Keefe’s hidden-camera sting of Steven Putansu, an assistant director at the Government Accountability

Office. Putansu is recorded describing a covert effort by GAO staff to “steal and back up” federal vaccine research data so it cannot be deleted by RFK Jr.’s HHS, which critics frame as illegal obstruction by entrenched bureaucrats and supporters defend as preserving “science.” The article argues this reflects a panicked attempt by a politicized “deep state” to protect the “safe and effective” vaccine narrative from scrutiny by RFK Jr., and calls for investigations into GAO, HHS data integrity, and possible violations of records and computer-crime laws

### Online ID Check

Missouri’s new online age-verification rule, effective November 30, 2025, requires sites where at least one-third of content is deemed harmful to minors—mainly explicit material—to verify users are over 18 via government ID, digital ID, or approved transactional data or face

civil penalties up to roughly \$10,000 per day. Digital rights advocates say the vague “harmful” standard and ID-heavy system create a de facto identity checkpoint for adult internet use, chilling lawful speech and exposing users to privacy and surveillance risks, and predict a mix of geoblocking, VPN workarounds, and court challenges as seen in other states.

### Botulism in Baby Food

A nationwide infant botulism outbreak linked to ByHeart formula has reached 37 confirmed cases in 17 U.S. states, with illness onset dates from August 9 to November 19, 2025; all infants have been hospitalized but none have died so far. After detecting Clostridium botulinum type A in samples from three lots, ByHeart recalled all formula



on November 11 and now says it cannot rule out contamination across all lots, while regulators warn that some recalled products remained on shelves and urge parents to watch for symptoms like constipation, weak sucking, lethargy, and breathing problems and to report suspected cases. Parents of at least two affected infants have filed negligence suits, and FDA and CDC updates continue as more lab results arrive.

### Israel Seeks Security Pact

supplied to Israeli forces after October 7 are now being adopted by hundreds of American law-enforcement agencies, illustrating how tools refined in conflict can migrate into domestic policing with limited public oversight.

Golden Dome introduces another dimension. Announced by President Trump in May, the \$175-billion project is framed as a missile-interception system. Yet, its architecture depends on integrated sensor networks and real-time data flows. Aside from Lockheed Martin, industry reporting points to possible involvement of SpaceX, Palantir, and Anduril. Those are firms already embedded in the

defense and “national security” sectors and are central to surveillance, AI, and autonomous targeting. With few details publicly disclosed, concerns are growing that Golden Dome’s real function may lie closer to integrated surveillance than to straightforward deterrence.

So, the United States is being asked to finance and solidify technologies that are, by any reasonable reading, edging into the dystopian. For that reason alone, the reported plan does not resemble a prudent long-term investment. Its utility for Americans is not just dubious. It arrives at a moment when Israel’s influence over the U.S. political establishment is becoming more visible — and more openly questioned.
